The Applicant has got stuck up in the matter of being sent to the Training Centre at Wastik after having been promoted as PSI. In view of the punishment that he is undergoing by the order dated 3rd January, 2017 which punishment is minor punishment. The apprehension is that the other colleagues of the Applicant would join the training and the Applicant would be prejudiced. The Respondents seek time to file Affidavit-in-reply and I do not think, the PO is having instructions in the matter. Therefore, notice will have to be issued. I, however, make a few points very clear. In the first place that the returnable date will not be a longest one at all. Secondly, the Respondents may file their Affidavit-in-reply and also place the record, if any, relevant hereto ready for perusal on the next date itself. In case the others of the batch of the Applicant join the training, it is clarified that the issue of interim relief is kept open and the fact that the training has commenced, if it so happens, will be no ground to negate to the Applicant the same treatment just because the OA is pending. The Respondents in their Affidavit-in-reply has to why the Judgment of this Tribunal in OA 824/2012 (Shri D.P. Chavan Vs. Government of Maharashtra and one another, dated 26th February, 2013) which they themselves have apparently followed in case of Rajendra M. Bangar, Hanoji S. Chirmade and Dilip T. Shinde, this Tribunal in OA 821/2017, dated 11.9.2017 and the A'bad Bench of this Tribunal in OA 505/2017, dated 28.7.2017 has granted interim relief of stay. The significant aspect is that, in those two OAs, it was prima-facie found that the requirement of Transfer Act had not been complied with. The learned PO submitted that, at least one week's time be given for him to take instructions and then report back to the Tribunal the facts herein. I find that, in the same order, the 2nd Applicant above named came to be transferred and there had to be strong material to show that the case of the present Applicant was inferiorly placed when compared with the said two Applicants and that ought to have been done today itself. When the matters are moved for urgent relief, all concerned will have to pull up their socks and asking for time for the sake of it may not always suffice. For these reasons and for parity of reasoning, the order herein impugned in so far as it relates to the Applicant is stayed till the date next to the filing of the Affidavit-in-reply by the Respondents and he shall be allowed to function at the place where he has been transferred from by the impugned order.
