- 3. By filing the accompanying O.A. the applicant is seeking quashing and setting aside the order dated 06.11.2018 and 14.11.2018 respectively and further seeking direction to the respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to select and appoint the applicant on the said post.
- 4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has filed representations dated 06.11.2018 and 13.11.2018 respectively to the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 for cancellation of the selection of the respondent No.4 and for selecting him in his place.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that though the applicant has submitted the representations as referred above, in spite of waiting period of four years, no effective steps have been taken by the respondent No.4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant could not approach this Tribunal due to ill health of his mother. The certificate issued by Dr. Juber Ahamad is annexed to the Misc. Application marked as Annexure 'A-1' collectively and 'B-1' respectively. Learned counsel for the applicant further submits that due to outbreak of pandemic Covid-19 the applicant could not approach this Tribunal during the period of 2020 to 2022. There is no intentional or deliberate delay as such nor there is any inaction on the part of the applicant. The delay may be condoned.

6. Learned P.O. and learned counsel for respondent No.4 have strongly resisted the application on the ground that there is an inordinate delay caused in filing the Original Application for which no satisfactory explanation has been tendered by the applicant. Learned counsel for the

respondent No.4 submits that though the representation was decided in the year 2018 itself, however, the applicant did not approach this Tribunal forthwith. As a result thereof the delay has been caused solely due to inaction on the part of the applicant. There is no substance in Misc. Application and the same is liable to be dismissed.

7. It appears that though bv filing accompanying Original Application the applicant challenged the select list, however, has representations dated 06.11.2018 and 13.11.2018 submitted by the applicant for cancellation of selection of the respondent No.4 and selecting him in his place have not considered and no decision has been taken on the same. Consequently, the delay seems to have been occurred. Further due to outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic situation and imposition of lockdown and extension thereof from time to time, the applicant could not approach this Tribunal within stipulated time. Further the applicant's mother was suffering from ill health during the year of 2022. Thus there is no inaction on the part of the applicant. Further the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Suo Motu Writ Petition (C) No. 3** of 2020 has passed the orders time to time in the backdrop of the outbreak of Covid-19 and the declaration of the lockdown in connection thereto and thus extended the period of limitation applicable to the proceedings before the Courts/Tribunals. It appears that as per the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the period from 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022 has been excluded for the purpose of limitation as may be prescribed under any general or special laws in respect of all judicial or quasi-judicial proceedings.

8. Thus considering the entire aspect of the case I am of the opinion that the applicant is prevented from sufficient cause to approach this Tribunal within stipulated time. I am thus inclined to condone the delay subject to certain costs. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) The Misc. Application No. 85/2023 is hereby allowed.
- (ii) The delay of 3 years, 2 months and 23 days caused in filing the accompanying O.A. under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act,
