Insofar as regular pension is concerned, the proposal is recently forwarded to the office of Accountant General and it is under process.</li> <li>7. As such nothing survive in the O.A. it needs to be disposed of.</li> <li>8. In view of the O.A. is disposed of with directions to the Respondent No.4 to take follow-up in respect of the proposal forwarded to the office of A.G. on 19.11.2018 and ensure that final pension will be sanction within two months from today.</li> <li>9. Learned Advocate for the Applicant prayed for liberty to recover the interest on delayed payment.</li> <li>10. 




