2. Being aggrieved by the impugned final list of the candidates eligible for recommendation published on 19.07.2023 for the post of Police Sub Inspector, Non-Gazetteed Group-B, the applicants have preferred the present Original Application. The applicants have objected validity of the Government Circular dated 13.03.2023 issued by respondent No. 2, whereby the period has been extended for obtaining / submitting Non-Creamy Layer certificate for the years 2019 and 2020 assigning reason of the period of COVID-19 during the said period.

3. Shri A.B. Chalak, learned counsel appearing for the applicants submitted that the advertisement of the post, which further process has been carried out was issued on 28.02.2020 and the last date for submitting application was 19.03.2020. Learned counsel invited my attention to clause 3.9 and 3.13 of the advertisement No.

260/2021 dated 10.12.2021. Learned counsel submitted that candidates who were under obligation to submit the Non-Creamy Layer certificate were required to submit the same having validity on the last date of filing of the application. Learned counsel submitted that by issuing Circular dated 13.03.2023 the said period has been extended and some relaxations have been granted for such candidates to submit the certificates of the years 2021-22 and 2022-23 instead of 2019-20 and 2020-21. According to the learned counsel, Circular so issued is contrary to the conditions incorporated in the advertisement and have prejudicially affected the right of the applicants. It is the contention of the applicants that because of Circular dated 13.03.2023, the candidates who do not possess valid or required Non-Creamy Layer certificate as required as per the terms in the advertisement have now been interviewed and their names have also been included in the final select list of the recommended candidates. Some such candidates are respondents in the present Original made party Application. Learned counsel for example submitted that applicant No. 1 belongs to DTA category and was liable to be recommended, if respondent No. 13 not been given benefit of Circular dated 13.03.2023. Learned counsel submitted that similar is case of the applicant No. 4, who belongs to OBC category and whose chances of being selected and recommended have been taken

away because of recommendation of respondent No. 10, who has also been benefited by the Circular dated 13.03.2023. In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, learned counsel for the applicants has prayed for interim relief, thereby restraining respondents from proceeding further with the recommendation process till disposal of the present Original Application.

4. Learned C.P.O. has sought time to file affidavit in reply in the present matter. Insofar as prayer of interim relief is concerned, learned C.P.O. submitted that ordinarily process of recruitment cannot be arrested. Learned C.P.O. further submitted that fate of the present applicants and / or prayers made in the present Original Application depends upon the validity of the Circular dated 13.03.2023, which has been challenged by the applicants in the present matter. Learned C.P.O., however, submitted that at the interim stage when say of the respondents is not on record, no prima-facie conclusion also can be recorded as about validity of the said Circular. In the circumstances, he opposed for grant of any interim relief.

5. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicants and the State authorities. I have

also gone through the documents filed on record. From the documents there is reason to believe that if the benefit of Circular dated 13.03.2023 is not given, some of the applicants do possess better chances of their recommendation. Two examples which the learned counsel has given in his arguments revealed said position. However, when the validity of the circular has been challenged, no prima-facie conclusions are possible to be recorded at the interim stage. In the circumstances, the relief as has been sought by way of interim relief is difficult to be granted. However, the interest of the present applicants can be duly protected by making selection /recommendation of the candidates, who have been given benefit of Circular dated 13.03.2023 subject to outcome of the present Original Application. Hence, the following order :-

<u>ORDER</u>

(i) Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 07.09.2023.

(ii) Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

(iii) Applicants are authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper

Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that though the applicant is eligible to be appointed on the post of Deputy Education Officer in view of the decision rendered by this Tribunal on 04.10.2018 in O.A. No. 634/2017, his name has not been included in the list of eligible candidates and resultantly he has not been called for interview. Learned counsel submitted that in identical matters this Tribunal has directed MPSC to call the said applicants for interview subject to outcome of the Original Applications filed by them. The applicant has placed on record the order passed in O.A. No. 861/2023 by the Principal Seat of this Tribunal at Mumbai on 18.07.2023. Learned counsel in the circumstances has prayed for similar relief in favour of

the present applicant. It is contended that interviews are scheduled on 26th and 27th of this month.

3. Learned C.P.O. submitted that in view of the order passed by the Division Bench at Nagpur of the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay and by the Principal Seat of this Tribunal at Mumbai in O.A. No. 861/2023 on 18.07.2023, MPSC decided to call all the candidates for interview, who have secured more than cutoff marks and has accordingly declared the list of such candidates irrespective of the fact whether or not they have approached the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal or the Hon'ble High Court for ventilating their grievance. The applicant in the present matter has placed on record said list at page Nos. 58 to 61 of the paper book. Learned C.P.O. submitted that if the name of the present applicant is not appearing in the said list, it has to be assumed that he has not secured the cutoff marks. Learned C.P.O. submitted that in the aforesaid circumstances, no interim relief can be granted in favour of the applicant as has been sought by him.

4. On such submissions made by learned C.P.O., learned counsel for the applicant submitted that cutoff marks are declared by the MPSC only for the Open category candidates. Learned counsel submitted that the

applicant belongs to Scheduled Caste category and cutoff marks for the said category are not declared by the MPSC. Learned counsel for the applicant in the circumstances submitted that said issue can be decided finally, however, if the applicant is not allowed to appear for interview, more complications are likely to occur and the applicant will be deprived of his right to be considered for the advertised post.

5. Learned C.P.O. referring to the argument of learned counsel, submitted that the cutoff marks were declared by MPSC for the Open category candidates on 01.04.2022. Learned C.P.O. further submitted that on 16.10.2018 itself the Government while its Circular, had declared that having regard to the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in the matter of 'reservation in promotion' and since the said order is not stayed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, social reservation may not be applicable for the Limited Departmental Examination-2017 for the post of Deputy Education Officer and equivalent posts and all the posts would be filled in purely on the basis of merit. In the circumstances according to the learned C.P.O., contention raised on behalf of the applicant cannot be considered.

6. After having considered the submissions made as above, it does not appear to me that any case is made out for grant of interim relief as has been prayed by the applicant.

7. Learned counsel for the applicant tendered G.R. dated 07.05.2021 in order to contend that the promotional posts were also liable to be filled in as per the position of the said post as on 25.05.2004. Learned counsel also placed on record G.R. dated 25.05.2004 and submitted that both these G.Rs. if conjointly read, it cannot be said that all the promotional posts are to be filled in only on the basis of merit.

8. I have gone through the G.R. dated 07.05.2021. It cannot be interpreted to mean as has been interpreted by the learned counsel for the applicant. At this juncture, having regard to the Government Circular dated 16.10.2018 the position as on today is that the reservation has not been made applicable for the promotional post of Deputy Education Officer, to be filled in on the basis of Limited Departmental Examinaion-2017.

9. Admittedly, name of the present applicant is not appearing in the list, who have been called for interview, meaning thereby that he has failed in securing the cut-

off marks. In the circumstances, I see no case is made out by the present applicant for grant of any interim relief. All his contentions would be considered on merit at the time of final hearing after pleadings are complete.

2. The applicant has claimed parity with the applicant in O.A. No. 861/2023 and has therefore, claimed similar interim relief, which has been granted in favour of such candidates.

3. From the averments raised in the Original Application, there is reason to believe that the present applicant is eligible to be considered for the post of Deputy Education Officer having regard to the decision rendered by this Tribunal in O.A. No. 634/2017. Now it has to be considered whether the applicant is entitled for interim relief as has been claimed by him seeking direction against the MPSC to call him for interview. As has been argued by the learned counsel appearing for the applicant this Tribunal has earlier given such directions to the MPSC by way of interim order in some of the O.As. The applicant has therefore, prayed for similar relief in his favour.

4. It is true that in some matters this Court has passed interim orders, thereby directing the MPSC to call the applicants in the said O.As. for interview subject to outcome of the said O.As. The order passed by this Tribunal is based on the order passed by the Principal Seat of this Tribunal at Mumbai on 18.07.2023 in O.A. No. 861/2023, as well as, the order passed by Nagpur Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in W.P. No. 5059/2022 on 23.06.2023. After passing of said order, the subsequent developments have taken place, which required to be noted. After the orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court, as well as, the Principal Seat of this Tribunal at Mumbai, MPSC took a decision to conduct the interview of all such candidates having identical claims as raised by the applicant in O.A. No. 861/2023 and who have secured more than cutoff marks. The MPSC has accordingly published the list of such candidates and have called them for interview on 26th and 27th of July, 2023.

5. It is the contentions of the applicant that since MPSC did not publish the merit list, the applicant is unaware of marks earned by him. In the circumstances, the applicant has prayed for interim relief seeking direction against the MPSC to call the applicant for interview subject to outcome of the present Original Application.

6. As noted hereinabove, MPSC has published the list of all the candidates, who have secured more than cutoff marks and has called them for interview. Name of the present applicant is not appearing in the said list. In the circumstances, inference has to be drawn that the present applicant has not received cutoff marks. In the circumstances, it is difficult to accept the request of the applicant for grant of interim relief as has been prayed by him. The contentions raised by the applicant can only be considered at the time of final adjudication of the present Original Application. Hence, the following order:-
