2. Respondent no.2-Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) had issued an advertisement on 30-01-2017 bearing advertisement no.02/2017 for the recruitment to the post of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector. Total 833 posts were advertised. Out of which 132 posts were reserved for Open Female candidates. Applicant claims to be belonging to NT(B) category. No post was reserved for NT(B) category candidate. The applicant in her application form, however, has indicated that her candidature may also be considered from Open category. Accordingly, the

applicant had paid examination fees prescribed for Open candidate i.e. Rs.337/-. Applicant appeared for preliminary examination and succeeded therein. She was, however, not allowed to appear in the main examination. Vide order passed on 11-07-2017, this Tribunal directed the Maharashtra Public Service Commission ("MPSC" for short) to permit the applicant to appear in the final examination. Accordingly, applicant appeared in the final examination.

3. It is the grievance of the applicant that though she had secured more marks than some of the lastly selected Open Female candidates, she was not selected for the reason that her migration was not permissible to Open Female category. MPSC published the revised recommendations list on 09-09-2019. In the list so published, MPSC in the foot note no.4 has specifically mentioned that subject to decision in O.A.No.436/2017, one post of Female Open category is kept vacant.

4. Learned Counsel for the applicant submitted that since beginning it was contention of the applicant that

Female candidates belonging to reserved category can very well compete for their selection in Open Female category. The learned Counsel submitted that at the relevant time, her contention was not accepted by the respondents and that was the reason the applicant was constrained to file the present O.A. Learned Counsel submitted that in view of the judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Saurav Yadav & Ors. V/s. State of Uttar Pradesh & Ors.**, [(2021) 4 SCC 542], the legal position now stands settled. In the said judgment, Hon'ble Apex Court has conclusively held that the candidates belonging to vertical reservation categories are entitled to be selected in "Open General" category on basis of their merit and in such circumstances, their selection cannot be counted against their respective quota for vertical reservation. The learned Counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant has received more marks than some of the last selected candidates in Open Female Category. The learned Counsel further submitted that on her own merit, applicant was liable to be selected from the Open Female

category. The learned Counsel reiterated that one post in Female Open category is kept vacant by MPSC subject to decision of the present O.A. In the circumstances, according to the learned Counsel without disturbing the appointments already made in Open Female category, the present applicant can very well be accommodated in the seat which is kept vacant subject to decision of the present O.A. The learned Counsel, therefore, prayed for allowing present O.A. and thereby direct the respondents to give her appointment on the seat kept vacant for Open Female candidate.

5. Learned CPO has not disputed the factual aspects in the matter and was fair enough in submitting that in view of the legal position now settled, appropriate order may be passed.

6. In view of the submission made as aforesaid, we may not require to make any detail discussion in the present matter. It is not in dispute that applicant belongs to NT(B) category for which there was no post earmarked. There is further no dispute that while

filling in the application form, the applicant has given an option that her candidature may be considered for Open General category. Admittedly, the applicant had paid the examination fees prescribed for Open category candidates. It is further not in dispute that the applicant has further not availed any other relaxation for the reserved category candidates, more particularly, in respect of age.

7. It is the matter of record that the applicant was not declared qualified for appearing in the main examination on the ground that she secured the marks in the preliminary examination less than the cut-off marks provided for Open General category. Applicant in the preliminary examination had received 14 marks whereas the cut-off fixed for Open General category was of 24 marks. It is further the matter of record that under the orders passed by this Tribunal, applicant was permitted to appear in the main examination and in the main examination, the applicant has received 128 marks. In fact, the permission so refused to the applicant for appearing in the main examination was on wrong reasons. Her candidature was liable to be

considered for Open Female category and she has secured more marks than the cut-off marks prescribed for Open Female category. Of course, now marks received by the applicant in the main examination are more material. As is revealing from the merit list, the last selected Female candidate has received 120 marks whereas the applicant has received 128 marks.

8. The main examination result of the present applicant was later on declared on 13-04-2022. The learned CPO has tendered across the bar letter received from the MPSC wherein it has been mentioned that in the main examination, the applicant had received 128 marks. In the said letter itself the MPSC has mentioned that the last selected Open Female candidate had received 120 marks. Now, therefore, there remains no doubt that the applicant has secured more marks than the last selected Open Female candidate. The applicant is, therefore, liable to be recommended by MPSC for her selection on the said post. One post of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector is kept vacant for candidate belonging to Open Female category. The applicant can very well be

accommodated against the said vacancy on the basis of her merit. For the reasons stated above, the following order is passed:

ORDER

(i) Respondent no.2 MPSC is directed to recommend the name of the present applicant for her appointment to the post of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector to respondent no.1 within 4 weeks from the date of this order.

(ii) Respondent no.1. Thereafter shall issue appointment order in favour of the applicant and the respondent no.1 thereafter shall issue appointment order in favour of the present applicant within next 4 weeks.

(iii) It is clarified that though the salary would become payable to the present applicant from the date of her joining, for other service benefits, she shall be deemed to have joined on the date on which the last selected candidate from Open Female category has joined.

(iv) O.A. stands allowed in the aforesaid terms. No order as to costs.
