5. On perusal of the record, prima-facie, it reveals that on the basis of the complaint received from the Teachers and the peoples representative with the concerned Minister regarding functioning and behavior of the applicant, the respondents have passed the impugned order and made temporary arrangement of handing over the charge of the post of District Sports Officer, Ahmednagar to Shri Vijay Santan, District Sports Officer, Pune.
