Learned P.O. on basis of information received from 'Joint Secretary, Medical Education & Drugs Department' who is personally present states that</p>

decision regarding 'Cancellation / Revocation' of the earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023 of 'Professor', 'Associate Professors' and 'Assistant Professors' of various 'Government Medical Colleges' including those of 'Applicants' categorized in 'Group - I' to 'Group - III' was taken at level of 'Competent Transferring Authority' and next 'Superior Transferring Authority' following 'Comprehensive and Full Review' undertaken by 'Medical Education and Drugs Department'. The 'Joint Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department' further clarified that decisions regarding 'Cancellations / Revocations' of the earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023 of 'Professor', 'Associate Professors' and 'Assistant Professors' of various 'Government Medical Colleges' were not taken in meeting of the 'State Cabinet'.

3. Learned P.O. further states that in respect of the Applicants who are categorized into 'Group - I' to 'Group - III'; the 'Medical Education and Drugs Department' has now cancelled earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023, 13.07.2023 and 10.08.2023 of 29 'Professors', 'Associate Professors' and 'Assistant Professors'. Out of the remaining cases of 9 'Professors', 'Associate Professors' and 'Assistant Professors', learned P.O. clarifies that 'Transfer Orders' of 2 'Professors', 'Associate Professors' and 'Assistant Professors' were 'Modified / Changed' as per their requests but in respect of remaining 7 'Professors', 'Associate Professor' and 'Assistant Professors' the 'Medical Education and Drugs Department' has taken conscious decision not to 'Cancel' or make no 'Modifications / Changes in their earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023.

4. Learned P.O. then states that in respect of these 7 'Professor', 'Associate Professor' and 'Assistant Professors'; the 'Medical Education and Drugs Department' now intends to contest them and hence seeks time to file individual 'Affidavit-in-Reply' in respect of these Applicants from 'Group I to Group III'.

5. The 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' therefore has consciously decided that case of 7 'Professors', 'Associate Professors' and 'Assistant Professors'; will now be contested by filing separate
