In fact the proposed amendment is just and necessary to determine the real question of controversy between

In the present matter affidavit in reply on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1 & 3 has already been filed on 24.03.2023 and the applicant was given opportunity for filing rejoinder affidavit on behalf of the applicant by today, if the applicant so wished. However, the rejoinder affidavit has not been filed as yet.
- 3. Learned Advocate for the applicant has pressed for grant of interim relief in terms of prayer cause para 27 (C) & 27 (D) of the O.A. which are reproduced ad verbatim for ready reference as follows:-

- "27 (C) Respondent No.1 may kindly be directed not to undertake the process of further promotion to the Cadre of Deputy Collector from amongst the Tahsildars, unless the process of regularization (Niyamitikaran), upon conversion of the post of Tahsildars from Divisional Cadre to the State Cadre, is completed, and a Final Seniority List accordingly is prepared, which has to be the basis for effecting promotions to the post of Deputy Collector;
 - (D) Pending the hearing and final disposal of this application, respondent No.1 may kindly be directed not to take up process of further promotions to the Cadre of Deputy Collectors unless Final Seniority List of the Cadre of Tahsildars is prepared, upon regularization (Niyamitikaran) press on account of conversion of the post of Tahsildars from Divisional cadre to the State cadre is completed.
- 4. Learned Advocate for the applicant has also submitted a copy of Government letter No. ,lvkjOgh 1002@iz-dz-223@bZ&9 dated 11.11.2002 along with a self-prepared chart showing by colour code the manner in which the seniority of the applicant gets compromised if the State level

combined seniority list of Nayab Tahsildars is not used for further consolidation into combined state-level seniority list of Tahsildars.

- Learned C.P.O. for the respondents has 5. opposed grant of interim relief as per prayer clauses in para 27 (C) & 27 (D) of O.A. on the ground that the seniority of Tahsildars, which is at present treated as Divisional cadre, is consolidated for preparation of combined seniority list of tahsildars as per provisions already in force and therefore, there is no likelihood in change in the same even after the cadre is treated as State Cadre so far as persons already working as Tahsildars prior notification of Nayab Tahsildars and Tahsildars to be State Cadre by G.R. dated 10.05.2021 which is annexed at page No. 28 of the P.B. at Annexure 'A-4'.
- 6. Learned C.P.O. for the respondents has also mentioned that the Principal Bench of this Tribunal had already passed order in C.P. No.

69/2022 in O.A.No. 339 of 200 on 21.02.2023 whereby, stay has not been granted on the promotion from the post of Tahsildars to Deputy Collector.

7. I have considered the submissions of both the sides. It is a fact that the post of Tahsildar is filled by the modes of promotion and nomination in prescribed ratio. Once a person is born in the cadre of Tahsildars by either of the two modes of recruitment, his divisional as well as combined state-level seniority is normally worked out / decided by the length of his regular service on the said post/ cadre at respective level or date of appointment, as the case may be. At this stage, it is not comprehended as to how the service length of Tahsildar on that post/ cadre will get sublimated/dissolved for the purpose of of combined seniority list preparation of Tahsildars at Divisional / State level and resultantly, the same ought to be worked out by computing regular service length in the cadre of

Naib Tahsildars/ date of appointment in the cadre of Nayab Tahsildar, as the case may be. Moreover, relevant rules prescribed in this regard under the Maharashtra Deputy Collectors (Recruitment, Fixation of Seniority, Confirmation) Rules, 1977 are in force, which set out governing rules for the purpose of promotion of Tahsildars to the post of Deputy Collector. Moreover, any order passed by the respondents shall be subject to outcome of the present O.A. which provides adequate protection to the interest of the applicants.

- 8. Upon considering all the facts before me, in my considered opinion, it may be premature to grant any stay on respondents taking any further procedure for promotion of Tahsildars to the post / cadre of Deputy Collector as per extent Rules. Hence, prayer for interim relief in aforementioned terms is rejected.

It is the contention of the applicant that the request transfer was sought by him on very genuine reason that his old aged father aged more than 80 years requires constant attendance. It is the contention of the applicant that despite the genuine reason for seeking transfer from Paithan, the respondents have refused the request for wrong reasons. It is the contention of the applicant that there are certain employees, who did not suffer any transfer and working at one and the same place for more than 15 years. According to the applicant, he is being discriminated by the respondents.

From the aforesaid ground the applicant has requested for quashment of the aforesaid communications and also sought direction against the respondents to post the applicant at Aurangabad. Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the posts are vacant at Aurangabad and applicant can very well be accommodated.

- 3. Learned Presenting Officer has opposed contentions raised in the application, as well as, prayers made therein. Learned P.O. submitted that the applicant has spent most of his service period at Aurangabad and only once he was transferred at other place than Aurangabad. It is further contended that Paithan is not far away from Aurangabad and several employees are day to day attending the office by residing at Aurangabad. Learned P.O. submitted that for the aforesaid reasons the request has been declined. Learned P.O. submitted that no error has been committed by the respondents in refusing the request of the applicant. Learned P.O., therefore, prayed for rejection of the O.A.
- 4. After having considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and respondent authorities, it appears to me that after filing of the application in the

year 2021, the period of around two years has lapsed. In view of submission made on behalf of the applicant that there are certain vacant posts at Aurangabad, it appears to me that the request of the applicant, if can be considered in ensuing general transfers, the respondents shall consider the same, on its own merit. From the facts which have come on record, it is difficult to say that any injustice has been caused to the applicant even in the past for the reason that he has spent most of his service period at Aurangabad.
