On 14.07.2020, the matter was adjourned on the request of learned P.O. to take instructions from the Respondents as to why the name of the Applicant could not be included in the waiting list for appointment on compassionate ground as *prima-facie* there was no hurdle to include his name in the waiting list.

- 1. Heard Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant, Smr., Kranti Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 and Shri C. T. Chandratre, learned Counsel for the Respondent No.3.
- 2. During the course of hearing, it is transpired that there is some mistake in Para No.7 of the Affidavit filed by Shri Rajaram Mane, Divisional Commissioner, Nashik, Para No.7 is as under:-
  - "7. I say and submit that, accardingly Divisional Commissioner Nashik by revoking previous order dated 29.03.2014 and 09.03.2015, Divisional Commissioner Nashik has possed modified order dated 07.07.2015 of establishment of Civil Services Boord under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner of the division considering the guidelines mentioned in G.R. dated 17.07.2015 of Department of Revenue & Forest with regard to the constitution of Civil Services Board for the transfer of the cadre of Tohslidar & Deputy Collector according to the directions given in the G.R. dated 31.01.2014."
- 3. Thus, the Divisional Commissioner seems to contend that he has passed the order dated 07.07.2015 about the establishment of Civil Services Board considering guidelines mentioned in G.R. dated 17.07.2015 issued by the Department of Revenue & Forest which was not in existence at the time of passing order dated 07.07.2015.
- 4. Smt. Kranti Gail wad, learned P.O. submits that there is some mistake in drafting Para No.7 and she should be allowed to file fresh Affidavit of Divisional Commissioner about composition of Civil Services Board and to explain mistake in Para No.7.
- 5. It appears that the Divisional Commissioner has sworn the Affidavit without reading its contents. Though, in law he was obliged to ensure the correctness of the contents of Affidavit before swearing the same. It appears that Affidavits are filed in haphazard manner and the Presenting Officers also did not bother to see its correctness before filing in the Tribunal.
- 6. In view of above I am inclined to grant opportunity to Respondents for filing fresh Affidavit of Divisional Commissioner, Nash k. It be filed within a week.
