#### **JUDGMENT**

- 1. Heard Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B. K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. This M.A. is filed in pending O.A. stating that there is no delay in filing O.A. and in alternative the Applicant prayed that delay could be of nine months and fifteen days and prayed to condone the delay.



- 3. The Applicant was initially appointed as Bhojan Sevak (Class IV employee) on 18.12.1993 from S. C. category. However, his caste certificate was found invalid, and therefore, he came to be terminated from the service w.e.f. 15.03.1994. Later, the Respondent No.2 Commandant, SRPF, Solapur by order dated 27.10.2014 again appointed he Applicant as Bhojan Sevak and while appointing, he referred to G.R. dated 08.12.1994 and 14.06.1995.
- 4. The Applicant has filed this O.A. challenging the order dated 28.11.2014 whereby the period out of service was treated as break in service not to be considered for retiral or any other monetary benefits.
- 5. The Applicant contends that the order dated 28.11.2014 was never served upon him. According to him for the first time, the order dated 28.11.2014 has been served upon him along with letter dated 15.07.2021. On this premise, he contends that O.A. being filed on 18.10.2021 is well within limitation.
- 6. In alternative, the Applicant contends that since there is reference in communication dated 15.07.2021 about service of impugned order to the Applicant on 01.06.2018 in that event considering Covid-19 Pandemic situation, the delay comes to nine months, and therefore, requested to condone the delay.
- 7. Learned P.O. sought to contend that the Applicant had knowledge of the order dated 28.11.2014 in view of communication dated 17.06.2015 whereby he was reappointed, and therefore, O.A. ought to have been filed within one year from 17.06.2015.
- 8. Insofar as order dated 17.06.2015 is concerned, it is revised order of reappointment. Indeed, the Applicant was reappointed by order dated 27.10.2014 and order dated 17.06.2015 is revised order of appointment.

- 9. True, in order dated 17.06.2015, there is reference that the out of service period was already treated as break in service.
- 10. However, material question is whether the Applicant was served with impugned order dated 28.11.2014 whereby the decision was taken to treat out of service period as a break in service. The Respondents have produced the record of services of order dated 17.06.2015 but no record of service of order dated 28.11.2014 is forthcoming. As such, even if there is no recital in order dated 17.06.2015, the fact remains that there is no service of order dated 28.11.2014. It was adverse order which ought to have been served on the Applicant so that he could have availed legal remedy. Mere reference of it in subsequent communication is not enough. It is for this reason, the copy of the said order was again given to the Applicant on 31.06.2018 as seen from communication dated 15.07.2021 when the Applicant raised grievance for pay and allowances of out of service period.
- 11. Here is may be noted that as per order dated 17.06.2015, the Applicant appears entitled for protection of G.R. dated 15.06.1995 and indeed, his seniority is also fixed from 15.06.1995. Thus, it appears that though the Applicant was entitled to protection of G.R. dated 15.06.1995, he came to be kept out of service for about 20 years.
- 12. Thus, the service of order dated 28.11.2014 was actually made upon the Applicant on 01.06.2018. The Applicant was, therefore, required to file O.A. within one year upto 01.06.2019. Later, in 2020, there was Covid-19 Pandemic situation and consequent lockdown and because of difficulties faced by litigants in Covid-19 situation, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Suo–Motu* W.P.No.03/2020 dated 10.01.2022 ordered that in cases where limitation would have expired during the period between 15.03.2020 to 28.02.2022 notwithstanding the actual balance period of limitation remaining, all persons shall have a limitation period of 90 days from 01.03.2022.

13. Thus, resultantly there could be delay of nine months i.e.

from 01.06.2019 to 15.03.2020.

14. Needless to mention while deciding application for condonation of

delay, the court needs to adopt liberal approach so as to advance

substantial justice and where the delay is reasonably explained, it needs

to be condoned.

15. In this view of the matter, I am inclined to condone the delay

caused in filing O.A. so as to decide the matter on merit.

16. M.A. is accordingly allowed with no order as to costs.

- 2. In O.A., the Applicant has challenged order dated 21.10.2013 whereby recovery of Rs.2,24,080/- was sought on account of retention of Quarter beyond permissible limit. Since there is delay in challenging the order, the Applicant has also filed Misc. Application for condonation of delay.
- 3. When today, the matter is taken up for hearing, learned Counsel for the Applicant has pointed out that during the pendency of matter, the Respondent has modified the initial order dated 21.10.2013 and passed fresh order on 14.04.2022 thereby seeking recovery of Rs.6,50,380/-.
- 4. It appears from perusal of order dated 14.04.2022 that earlier the penal charges were charged by lesser rate against the rate specified in this behalf, and therefore, the Respondent's recalculated the penal charges and calculated the amount due as Rs.6,50,380/-.
- 5. In view of above, learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that he has to challenge the order dated 14.04.2022 and sought permission to withdraw the M.A. and O.A. with liberty to challenge the order dated 14.04.2022 by filing sperate O.A.
- 6. Allowed to withdraw M.A. and O.A. with liberty to take further recourse of law as may be permissible.
