- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant mentioned that name of Applicant figures at 'Serial No.42' in the list of 'Non-eligible Candidates' because 'Preferential Criteria' has not been considered in respect of Applicant as per 'Para 9.3' of MPSC Advertisement No.053/2023 dated 13.09.2023.
- 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then stated that Applicant possesses 'Masters' Degree in Public Health (Nutrition) from 'MUHS' Nashik and therefore he fulfills the 'Preferential Criteria' as 'Para 9.3' MPSC per of Advertisement dated 13.09.2023. No.053/2023 Applicant was required to be called for 'Interview' for appointment to post of 'Director of Health Services, Maharashtra Medical & Health Services, Group-A' which is scheduled to be held on 23.08.2024 based on 'Preferential Criteria'.
- 5. Learned Advocate for Applicant submitted the 'Judgment' dated 16.11.2007 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2008) 1 SCC 362 [B. Ramakichenin @ Balagandhi vs. Union of India & Ors.].
- 6. Learned CPO per contra mentioned that Applicant was not found eligible to be called for 'Interview' and placed at 'Serial No.42' in the list of 'Non-eligible Candidates'; as he not only does not possess 'Experience' as per 'Para 9.2' of MPSC Advertisement No.053/2023 dated 13.09.2023 as modified later on 09.08.2024 in exercise of powers vested under 'MPSC Rules of Procedures' dated 03.09.2014, but also because Applicant

was not found to fulfill the 'Preferential Criteria' as per 'Para 9.3' of MPSC Advertisement No.053/2023 dated 13.09.2023.

- 7. The Affidavit-in-Reply filed on 23.08.2024 on behalf of Secretary, MPSC reiterates the Clauses 9.1, 9.2 and 9.3 of MPSC Advertisement No.053/2023 dated 13.09.2023 for post of Director of Health Services, Maharashtra Medical & Health Services, Group-A' which are as follows:-
 - 9.1 शैक्षणिक अर्हता- (i) Possess the M.B.B.S. Degree of a Statutory University or any other qualification specified in the First or Second Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956; Preventive and Social Medicine as
 - (ii) Possess a Post-graduate degree in any of the Clinical subjects or in specified in the First or Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, or any other qualification recognized as equivalent by the Medical Council of India.
 - 9.2 अनुभवः- Possess experience of Health Administration, Medical Relief or Family Planning in Government, Zilla Parishad or a Local Body of not less than ten years after acquiring Post-graduate qualifications mentioned in 9.1(ii)
 - 9.3 प्राधान्यशील अर्हता:- Provided that in the case of candidates possessing a Post-graduate degree in any clinical subjects, those possessing a Diploma in Public Health or equivalent in addition, will be given preference."
- 8. The learned CPO has referred the case of Shifana P.S. Vs. State of Kerala (SC) Civil Appeal No.4468/2013 decided on 04.03.2024 in support of their case.
- 9. The Applicant admittedly fulfills the requirement of Para 9.1. As he has completed MD (Pediatrics) on 03.06.2011 and as on the date of computation of experience as per MPSC Advertisement No.053/2023 dated 13.09.2023 i.e. 03.10.2023 is 12 years, 7 months and 16 days. However, MPSC has raised minimum criteria to 20 years' experience for S-25 pay scale and 25 years' experience for S-23 pay scale.
- 10. The Affidavit-in-Reply filed by MPSC mentions that Applicant therefore does not now possess the above enhanced Minimum Criteria of 'Experience' in 'Clause 9.2'. Further, Applicant does not fulfill the requirement of Preference under 'Clause 9.3', as 'Expert Committee' has given remarks that the 'Additional Qualification'

was not acceptable due to Applicant having degree in 'Master of Public Health in Nutrition' and not 'Master of Public Health'.

- 11. The 'Master of Public Health in Nutrition' is offered by MUHS, Nashik but it is distinct from 'Master of Public Health' which is separately offered by 'MUHS, Nashik'. Although it is for MUHS, Nashik to decide about their equivalence based on 'Judgment' of Hon'ble Supreme of India in *Unnikrishan CV and Ors. Vs. Union of India* & Ors. [2023 SCC Online SC 343] which is referred in case of Shifana P.S. Vs. State of Kerala (Cited supra) by decision of the 'Academic Body of MUHS, Nashik' through 'Specific Order' or 'Resolution'.
- 12. The equivalence of these two distinct Post Graduate Degrees of (a) 'Master of Public Health (Nutrition)' and (b) 'Master of Public Health' both offered by MUHS, Nashik cannot be gone into in 'Judicial Review' as per principles laid down in Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **Shifana P.S. Vs. State of Kerala** (Cited supra).
- 13. Even if it is accepted for a moment that the Applicant who Possesses Master of Public Health in Nutrition is having equivalent degree of Master of Public Health, still he cannot be said to be eligible for 'Interview' by MPSC for the post of 'Director of Health Services, Maharashtra Medical & Health Services, Group-A' scheduled on 30th August, 2024 because Applicant now gets barred by the requirement of enhanced Minimum Experience of 20 years' experience for S-25 pay scale and 25 years' experience for S-23 pay scale.
- 14. The opinion of 'Expert Committee' of MPSC cannot be gone into for judicial review as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment in **Bihar Public Service Commission Vs. Kamini (2007)** 5 SCC 519.

Tribunal's orders

15. The Applicant's case therefore does not merit consideration also as it seems that the MPSC has diligently followed due procedure as laid down in Para 11.1 and 11.2 of MPSC Advertisement No.053/2023 dated 13.09.2023 and also provisions of Rule 9(1)(5) and Sub-rule 5(a) and 5(d). The contents of Para 11.1 and 11.2 of MPSC Advertisement No.053/2023 dated 13.09.2023 are as follows:-

"99.9 प्रस्तुत जाहिरातीमध्ये नमूद केलेली शैक्षणिक अर्हता, अनुभव इत्यादी अर्हता किमान असून, किमान अर्हता धारण केली म्हणून उमेदवार मुलाखतीस बोलाविण्याकरिता पात्र असणार नाही.

99.२ जाहिरातीस अनुसरून प्राप्त अर्जाची संख्या आयोजाच्या कार्यनियमावलीतील तरतुदीनुसार वाजवी प्रमाणापेक्षा जास्त असेल आणि अर्ज सादर केलेल्या सर्व पात्र उमेदवारांच्या मुलाखती घेणे सोयीरकर नसल्यास मुलाखतीसाठी उमेदवारांची संख्या मर्यादित करण्याच्या दृष्टीने जाहिरातीमध्ये नमूद शैक्षणिक अर्हता आणि अथवा अनुभव यापेक्षा अधिक शैक्षणिक अर्हता, अनुभव किंवा अन्य योज्य निकष यांच्या आधारे अथवा चाळणी परीक्षेद्वारे मुलाखतीस पात्र उमेदवारांची संख्या मर्यादित करण्यात येईल."

- 16. The 'Judgment' in case of **B**. Ramakichenin @ Balagandhi vs. Union of India & Ors. (cited supra) is not helpful to the Applicant.
- 17. The Applicant therefore cannot be granted 'Interim Relief' to allow him to appear for 'Interview' for the post of 'Director of Health Services, Maharashtra Medical & Health Services, Group-A' which is scheduled to be held by MPSC on 30.08.2024. The 'Prayers' to grant 'Interim Relief' in 'Clause VIII' of this OA No.1007/2024 is rejected.

Learned Counsel has submitted that the Applicant has submitted options on 12.08.2024 and none of the options were considered though the posts are vacant. Learned Counsel has pointed out G.R. dated 29.10.2020 by which the post of Awal Karkun Cadre and Circle Officer post is to be filled on rotation basis upon completion of two years tenure. However, the tenure of Circle Officer/ Awal Karkun is extended for three years and to be filled on rotation basis as per the decision of the M.A.T. Bench Aurangabad dated 04.04.2018 passed in O.A.No.300/2017.

- 4. Learned Counsel has submitted that out of the preferential / options, the options at Serial No.2, Hotgi (South), Solapur and Serial No.3, Valsang (South), Solapur are vacant till today. She prays that any of the said post at Serial Nos.2 or 3 be kept vacant.
- 5. Learned P.O. is directed to place on record order dated 04.04.2018 passed in O.A.No.300/2017. Respondents are directed to keep any of the one post vacant, out of the options, at Serial No.2, Hotgi (South), Solapur or Serial No.3, Valsang (South), Solapur, till next date.
- 6. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
