- The applicant seeks selection to the post of Police Constable in view of advertisement dated 9.8.2019 published by respondent no.2. Though the applicant belongs to OBC category he inadvertently stated his caste as belonging to SBC in the online application form submitted on 13.9.2019. On 18.11.2021 his application was processed. Thereafter immediately on 22.11.2021 he made a representation for modifying from SBC to OBC category. He was called for interview and document verification, during which time it was found that he as wrongly mentioned his caste. The applicant secured 136 marks i.e. 91 in written and 45 marks in physical examination. The cut off marks for general category is 135, for OBC is 132 and for SBC it is 130 marks. The applicant therefore prays that he should be considered for selection as he has secured more than the cut off marks of all the categories.
- This Tribunal passed the following interim order on 7.4.2022:
 - In view of the fact that select list of 720 candidates is put on hold as the respondents have not filed affidavit in reply, we direct the respondents to declare the result for 719 posts. The result of one post is not to be declared till the next date."
- Ld. PO submits that applicant has wrongly mentioned his caste and there is no scope for correction in the said form and his candidature was rightly rejected.

Tribunal's orders

- 5. We express our view that law of the land which is settled in the case of R.K. Sabharwal & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. AIR 1995 SC 1371 in respect of migration, on the basis of merit irrespective of caste or category the candidate belongs to. Moreover, the applicant is meritorious candidate and he should be given appointment.
- 6. In view of the above, we direct the respondents to give appointment to the applicant to the post of Police Constable within two weeks. OA disposed off accordingly.

- 2. The Applicant stands retired on 31.05.2022 on the post of Stenographer (H.G.). While in service the Applicant was initially appointed on the post of Steno-Typist in 15.04.1985 and was promoted on the post of Stenographer (L.G.) 20.06.1996. Later, he was promoted on the post of Stenographer (H.G.) on 02.03.2021. He raised grievance that his Jr. namely Shri Atul Chavan was promoted on the post of Stenographer (L.G.) and joined on 30.12.1992. Whereas, the Applicant was promoted to the post of Stenographer (L.G.) 20.06.1996. He therefore made representation for Deemed Date of Promotion in the cadre of Stenographer (L.G.) w.e.f. 30.12.1992.
- 3. Significantly, Respondent No.2 vide communication dated 17.01.2019 sent proposal to the Government recommending Deemed Date of Promotion on par with Atul Chavan. However, no decision is taken, and eventually the Applicant stand's retired on 31.05.2022. The Applicant filed M.A. for condonation of delay along with O.A.
- 4. Indeed, no final decision is taken on the representation as well as proposal dated 17.01.2019 and 26.07.2019 forwarded by Respondent No.2 The Commissioner, Tribal Development Department, Nashik to Respondent No.1, The Principal Secretary, Tribal Development

Department. Indeed, the decision ought to have been taken at the earliest but not taken though the Applicant stands retired thereafter. Since no decision is taken the question of limitation does not survives.

- 5. In view of above, O.A. deserves to be disposed of with suitable direction.
- 6. M.A. and O.A. are disposed of with direction to the Respondent No.1 to take decision on the proposal dated 17.01.2019 and proposal dated 26.07.2019 sent by Respondent No.2 in accordance to Rules within 6 weeks from today. Decision as the case may be shall be communicated to the Applicant and will be at liberty to avail further legal remedy if felt aggrieved.
