5. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
6. The service may be done by hand delivery/ speed post/courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.
7. In case notice is not collected within seven days and if service report on affidavit is not filed three days before returnable date, MA shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

The Applicant has filed O.A. 338/19 challenging the dismissal order and also compulsory retirement. On this background notice was issued by Deputy Commissioner of Police directing the Applicant to vacate the quarter which was allotted to him while he was in service.

4. Thus apparently, Applicant is in unauthorized possession of the quarter for more than 4 years. Prayer for allowing him to continue in the quarter till decision of O.A. No. 338/19 is not at all sustainable, as he has no right much less legal right to continue the possession of quarter.
