Learned Counsel has placed on record the letter dated 14-02-2020 addressed by the Dean, Dr. Shankarrao Chavan Government Medical College and Hospital, Vishnupuri, Nanded to the Commissioner, Medical Education. Mumbai wherein the list employees is annexed and it has been informed in the said letter that there are Badli Workers working in the Hospital for more than 25 years and even they had worked effectively in the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.
- 5. Learned Counsel submits that there is recurring cause of action since issue is not finally decided. As such, learned Counsel submits that the delay deserves to be condoned as there is no inaction on the part of the applicant and there is no deliberate or intentional delay.

- 6. Learned P.O. strongly opposed for condoning the delay on the ground that sufficient reasons are not mentioned and the delay has not been explained satisfactorily, and therefore, the application is liable to be rejected.
- 7. By filing the accompanying O.A. applicant is seeking directions to the respondents to regularize his services as Badli Worker in class-IV cadre. It is not disputed that the applicant is working as Badli Worker in the Respondent no.3 Government Hospital for more than 25 years and same is reflected in the letter dated 14-02-2022 issued by the Dean, Dr. Shankarrao Chavan Government Medical College and Hospital, Vishnupuri, Nanded. I, thus, agree with the submissions made by the applicant that there is recurring cause of action as the issue is still pending.
- 8. There is no inaction on the part of the applicant, so also the delay is not intentional or deliberate. It appears that unless and until the decision is taken in this regard by the Government, which will be in consonance with the decision taken in respect of Badli Workers working in
