2. Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 15th December, 2018.

3. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

4. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

5. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

Umadevi and others [Appeal (civil) 3595-3612 of 1999], the said requires to be cancelled and, therefore, the order dated 29.10.2018 impugned of discontinuation of the services of the applicant is passed [Annexure 'A-11', page-88]. In the without making circumstances. anv further comments on merits, status quo to discontinuation of the services of the applicant is hereby granted till filing of the affidavit in reply.
