4. As is revealing from the pleadings in the O.A., the promotions to the post of Peon from the cadre of Kotwal could not be made during the period of Corona Pandemic and it is therefore the contention of the applicant that he could not get the appointment to the post of Peon though he fulfills the prescribed eligibility criteria for such promotional appointment. It has also been pleaded that for promotion to the post of Peon from the cadre of Kotwal the upper age limit is 45 years. It is further contended that the applicant will be completing the age of 45 years on 04-08-2023. In the aforesaid circumstances, the request has been made on behalf of the applicant to give directions to the respondents to consider the case of the applicant expeditiously, as an exception, as he is attaining the age of 45 years on 04-08-2023 and on scrutiny, if he is found eligible, to consider him for appointment on the post of Peon.

5. It is also stated that the departmental action has also been initiated against the applicant. It is the contention of the applicant that she has already submitted explanation and will defend the departmental proceedings, as well as, criminal case, however, there was no reason for the respondents to withhold provisional pension. In the circumstances, learned counsel for the applicant while praying for issuance of notices in the present matter has also prayed for interim directions against the respondents to process the case of the applicant for grant of provisional pension to her.

3. From the documents it appears that the criminal case has been registered against the applicant along with certain other employees and the same is pending. Departmental action is also appears to have been initiated

against the applicant. The applicant has however, not filed complete documents on record. Since the applicant has retired on 31.1.2022 in spite of the fact that the criminal prosecution and the departmental proceedings are pending against her, the respondents are supposed to process her case for grant of provisional pension. In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to pass the following order: -
