3. The learned Advocate for Applicant submits that Applicant is a Medical Officer and seeks benefit of Notification dated 23.02.2022 thereby increasing the date of retirement upto 60 years. The learned Advocate for Applicant submits that Applicant is going to be superannuated after attaining age of 58 years.

5. The learned CPO submits that above group of OAs (OAs1107/2023 & Others) are fixed for Final Hearing on 06.02.2024.

6. In this matter, we are of view that the last Proviso Clause to Notification dated 23.02.2022 is required to be interpreted in the above group of OAs.

7. The learned CPO pointed out that the opinion is given by Chief Secretary is different.

8. We are aware of the fact that this case being identical, the same orders of 'Interim Relief' are sought by the learned Advocate for Applicant. However, we are of the view that in this matter, unnecessary complications are created and this issue requires to be decided expeditiously. If it is found that all Medical Officers entitled to extension from 58 years to 60 years, we can grant benefit antedated to the present Applicant.
