- 5. Learned P.O. thereupon states that the Applicant has been relieved today by order of 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' and Commissioner of Police (Traffic), Pimpri-Chinchwad' has been given to 'Deputy Commissioner of Police (Head Quarter), Pimpri-Chinchwad'.

#### Tribunal's orders

- The 'Child' is 'Mentally Retarded' to an extent of 75% and Applicant as 'Father' is 'Care Giver' under 'Section 2(d) of 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016'. Therefore provisions of this 'Special Legislation' could not have been overlooked by (i) 'P.E.B.' while making recommendation to 'Home Department' and (ii) 'Home Department' while taking decision as 'Competent Authority' under 'Section 22N' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951', since this material fact had been specifically mentioned in proposal submitted by 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad'.
- 7. The 'Government Of India's, Department of Personnel and Training vide Memorandum F.No.42011/3/2014-Estt (Res) dated 08.10.2018' are appreciably progressive; having exempted Government Servants of Central Government who are 'Care-givers' of their dependent Daughter/ Son/ Parents/ Spouse /Brother/ Sister with 'Specified Disability' under 'Section 2' of 'Right of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016' from the routine exercise of 'Transfer & Rotational Transfer' subject to 'Administrative Constraints'.
- 8. The 'Child' of Applicant who is 'Mentally Retarded' to an extent 75%, would certainly suffer in silence in absence of 'Father' as 'Care Giver'; as the Applicant stands helpless & unable to be with his 'Child'. The Applicant obviously cannot show disobedience to Service Laws, Rules and Regulations and to directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 which are applicable equally to him as well as other Police Officers.
- 9. The 'Home Department' against this backdrop must now respond to call of conscience to review the Order dated 28.02.2024 with concurrence of 'Principal Secretary' and 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State'; so as to uphold 'Legal Rights' of the 'Child' of Applicant who is 'Mentally Retarded' an extent of 75% as these are enshrined in 'The Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016'.
- 10. The case 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' against these facts and circumstances is directed to not to give regular charge of the post of 'Deputy Commissioner of Police (Traffic), Pimpri-

- 3. The learned Advocate for Applicants submits that M.A.No.10/2024 is filed for condonation of delay of 1 Year and 10 Months. He submits that cause of action is of 22.02.2022. So the period of limitation got over on 21.02.2023. OA is filed on 20.12.2023. Thus, the delay nearly of 10 months.
- 4. The Applicant challenges the Seniority List dated 22.02.2022. The learned Advocate for Applicant submits that Applicant made representation on 17.03.2022. Then he sought information under RTI on 23.09.2022. So again comprehensive representation of the seniority was issued on the application filed on 08.11.2023 and thus, there is delay.
- 5. Shri K.R. Jagdale, learned Advocate and Shri U.V. Bhosle, learned Advocate for private Respondents submits that there is no satisfactory explanation about delay except the reason of making representations and there was no other ground to explain the delay. He relies on the Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K. Ramchandran Vs. State of Kerala & Anr. dated 19.09.1997 reported in 1997 (72) ECR 785 (SC).
- 6. In the case of P.K. Ramchandran, there was delay of 565 days for filing Civil Appeal and no satisfactory reason was given by condoning

#### Tribunal's orders

the delay. Hence, Hon'ble Supreme Court held that the Courts have no power to extend the statutory period of limitation on equitable grounds.

In the present case, there is delay of 10 months. The dates given by learned Advocate for the Applicants disclose that Applicant had raised his first objection to the Seniority List within one month of impugned order or the order which is under challenge in this OA. Though in the cases of condonation of delay, generally, this Tribunal has taken a view that placing the representation one after other and waiting for reply is itself not a ground to condone the delay. However, in the present case, the delay is of 10 months and Applicant has made representation to the authority raising objection about seniority. It is the authority to consider the objections raised or grievance raised about the Seniority List and therefore the reason given by Applicants that they waited for some time subsequently for collecting information under RTI and made composite representation are the reasons can be accepted as satisfactory grounds to condone the delay in this matter.

8. On the above background, the delay is condoned. MA No.10/2024 stands allowed.

- 2. The Applicant is widow of deceased Government servant Bharat Bhosale. The deceased Government servant was working as 'Health Assistant' on the establishment of Resp. 1- The District Malaria Officer, Satara. He stands retired on 11.5.2018 on attaining the age of superannuation. Thereafter, he passed away on 01.07.2019 leaving behind his widow (present Applicant).
- Learned Counsel submits that Applicant's 3. deceased husband had already commuted his pension to the extent to 40% during his life time and Respondent has paid the commutation amount to the Applicant on 29.09.2020 i.e after sad demise of late Bharat Bhosale. Learned Counsel states that in view of revised pay scale, all the benefits except commutation of pension in terms of 7th Pay Commission was given to widow. The only issue remains about arrears of commutation of pension.

### Tribunal's orders

- 4. Learned Counsel further submits that as per Finance Department G.R. dated 05.02.2021, the Applicant after the death of deceased Government servant made an application on 28.09.2021 to Respondent No.1 claiming difference of commutation amount. However, no decision has been taken by the Respondent on representation made by Applicant on 28.09.2021.
- 5. Learned Counsel for Applicant therefore filed this O.A. seeking direction to Respondents for extending the benefits of GR dated 05.02.2021 and to release arrears of difference of commutation amount as per 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission.
- 6. Learned Counsel for Applicant pointed out that during the pendency of Original Application, updated GR dated 31.01.2024 has been issued by the Finance Department to give the benefit of revised Commutation of Pension as per 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission to the pensioners who retired from service between 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018. The relevant para of said G.R. reads as under:-
