The Applicant therefore contends that because of Covid-19 pandemic situation and lockdown, he could not file O.A. within the period of limitation of one year. In this behalf, learned Advocate for the Applicant referred to the order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in Suo Motu With Petition No.03/2020, dated 10.01.2022 wherein it has been held that in cases where limitation would have expired during the period between 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022 notwithstanding the actual balance period of limitation remaining, all persons shall have a limitation period of 90 days from 01.03.2022.
- 4. In the present case, limitation expired in between 15.03.2020 to 28.02.2022, and therefore, O.A. ought to have been filed on or before 01.06.2022. However, it is filed on 27.02.2023. Therefore, M.A. for delay is filed to condone the delay of 8 months.

- 2. Applicant prays for appointment in Open Female Category for the post of Scientific Officer, Group-B. At the interim stage, this Tribunal has passed orders on 17.03.2017 and also on 20.03.2023 by which interim stay was granted that Respondent No.5 that she should not be the in Open Female Category till final disposal of O.A.
- As per revised merit list dated 10.07.2017 issued by the M.P.S.C. under the signature of Mr. Vivek Shankarrao Deshmukh, Under Secretary in office of Maharashtra Public Commission, Respondent No.5, Ms. Kavita Narendra Naik was selected in Open General Category as she has secured 66 marks. Thus, the post of Open Female was offered to Ms. Walve Geeta Shridhar, the candidate at serial No.6 in the said list who secured 65 marks. The Applicant stands at serial No.8 in the said merit list as she secured 62 marks. Ms. Walve did not have NCL certificate so she should not be considered in Open Female Category though she has secured 65 marks i.e. more than the Applicant. At serial No.7 in the said list the candidate Ms. Mhatre Manisha Bhimrao had

secured 64 marks i.e. more than the applicant. However she was not holding NCL certificate therefore she was to be considered in Open Category and as no post was available in Open Category so she was not appointed. However, no post was available in OBC, but she is entitled to get appointed in Open Female Category with 62 marks.

- 4. We have gone through the affidavit-in-reply dated 27.07.2017 of Respondent, M.P.S.C. filed through Vivek Shankarrao Deshmukh, Under Secretary. Learned P.O. has relied on paragraph 39 of the said affidavit and has argued that the applicant has secured lesser marks i.e. 62 marks. Therefore, the candidate who has secured more marks i.e. Ms. Mhatre Manisha Bhimrao, whose name appears at serial No.7 in the said list and standing above the Applicant has claimed in OBC with NCL certificate. However, the fact is Ms. Mhatre Manisha Bhimrao was not holding NCL certificate.
- 5. Under such circumstances we are inclined to pass the following order:
 - (a) O.A. is allowed.
 - (b) Applicant is to be recommended by M.P.S.C. for the post of Scientific Officer, Group-B pursuant to the advertisement dated 31.07.2015 as the Open Female Category. The name of the Applicant is to be recommended by M.P.S.C. within four weeks as the office of M.P.S.C. is going to be shifted.
 - (c) Seniority of the Applicant is to be considered as per deemed date of the appointment of the candidates who were appointed from that select list.
