<u>ORDER</u>

- 1. Heard Shri B. Deshmukh, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri K.B. Bhise, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. Admit.
- 3. Heard at length on the point of interim relief.
- 4. Applicant's claim is based on following facts:-
 - (a) By virtue of Government decision dated 30.09.2015 the Medical Officer serving in the pay scale of Rs.15600-39100 with grade pay of Rs.6600 and above shall be retired on attaining 60 years of age.
 - (b) Medical Officers in Group 'B' are now included in Group 'A'. Therefore Applicant should not be superannuated at 58 years of age.
 - (c) He is ought to be superannuated by impugned order dated 6.1.2016 w.e.f. 30.04.2016.
 - (d) The order of retirement is issued by the District Health Officer, Z.P. Satara.



- (e) Since the Applicant is absorbed in Government Service now, the D.H.O. has no powers to issue the order of retirement.
- 5. Points of facts which have surfaced after perusal of record, are sumarrised as below:-
 - (a) Applicant's claim is that he is absorbed in Government Service pursuant to the Government decision dated 17th October, 2014.
 - (b) Though the Applicant claims that he belongs to Medical Officer Group 'A', the absorption order dated 17.10.2014 shows that he was serving as Medical Officer Group 'B'.
 - (c) It is evident from Exh. 'G' order dated 11.09.2014 page 38 that the Pay Scale of Rs.15600-39100 and grade pay of Rs.6600 is conferred upon the Applicant on account of Assured Career Progression scheme and not because the Applicant was appointed in Medical Officer Group 'A' category on certain conditions.
 - (d) Condition No.4 of order dated 11.09.2014 Exh. 'G' states that though higher pay scale is given, applicant shall continue in Medical Officer Class-III in Grade-2 only.
- 6. It is thus evident that through the order of granting higher pay scale under assured career progression scheme, proves that the Applicant in serving in the category of Medical Officer Group 'B, and was absorbed in Government Service in said category only.
- 7. Though Applicant was absorbed in the employment of Government he was actually serving under the control of Z.P. Satara, and formal order of retirement had to be issued by his immediate superior as he was serving in Class-III category.
- 8. Conferment of pay in higher scale under A.C.P. does not upgrade calss or category of Government Servant. By conferment of higher pay due to A.C.P., A Government Servant gets monetory consolation and nor upgradation in status.
- 9. In the result Applicant is not entitled to be governed under the scheme had his age of superannuation extended upto 60 years, which decision is taken by the Government as an exception measure that for only 3 years and without applying to all

those who are serving in particular group and pay scale, or those who are working on posts in lower pedestal.

- 10. Impugned communication is a notice or intimation and not an order of retirement. Hence it cannot be said that the D.H.O. has ordered Applicant's superannuation.
- 11. Therefore Applicant is not entitled for granting of Interim relief.
- 12. The Original Application shall come up for hearing in due course.
