Perused the record and heard Mr. M.D. Lonkar, the learned Advocate for the Applicants and Mrs. A.B. Kololgi, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

The Applicants seek interim relief in respect of the possession of a residential quarter which was given to the father - the Applicant No.1 in connection with his job as a Police Constable. His daughter - the 2nd Applicant has since been appointed as Woman Police Constable and she is staying with her father in the same premises. Post retirement in May, 2015, the Applicant No.1 has not so far vacated the premises in question and that has given rise to the present proceedings stung by the contents of what is Exh. U' (Page 39 of the Paper Book (PB), in which it is set out inter-alia that should the Applicant No. I fail to vacate the premises action under Section 31(1)(A) of the Bombay Police Act, 1951 would go underway. From Exh. E' (Page 27 of the PB), it clearly appears that the Applicant No.2 daughter has not been paid House Rent Allowance eversince April, 2010. At Exh. M' (Page 45 of the PB), the Respondents have conveyed to the 1st Respondent that in accordance with the provisions therein quoted, although the said residential accommodation cannot be transferred to the name of the 2nd Applicant, upon payment of the penal rent, it would be possible to give the same to the 2nd Applicant.

It is in the context of the above referred facts that the relief of a declaration and voiding the impugned ordaer above referred to, stated in various ways in the prayer clause are sought. Vide prayer clause (e), interim relief is sought against the move to evict the Applicants from the residential accommodation.

The learned PO strongly objects to any interim relief be granted. It appears from her submission that nobody from the office of Respondents is present to give instructions to her. Notice was served on 15th May, 2017. If the Respondents were insistant on the Applicants paying penal rent, then there is no justification there for withholding the HRA of the Applicant No.2 since before the date of retirement of the Applicant No.1. In my opinion, till such time, as the Affidavit-in-reply is filed, the interim relief as herein sought will have to be given, more particularly because the state of the record, such as it is,

does not give any indication of any justification for not paying the HRA to the 2nd Applicant. Hence, till the date next to the filing of the reply, the Respondents shall be restrained from translating into reality the threat contained in the impuvned order in anyi manner whatsoever.
