2. Applicant, Head Clerk challenges order dated 14.08.2024 passed by the Respondent No.1 wherein the Applicant is transferred from the office of City Survey Officer, Andheri, District Mumbai Suburban to the office of Deputy Superintendent of Land Records, Vasai, Dist. Palghar.

3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant has submitted that the Applicant has completed the requisite period of her posting as she was posted in the office of City Survey Officer, Andheri in the year 2017. Learned Counsel has submitted that last year she was due for transfer, but the Department did not transfer her. Learned Counsel challenges the order dated 14.08.2024 on the following grounds :

(a) Respondent is not the competent authority. As per Notification dated 03.03.2020, if a Government Servant is Group-C and is transferred within the Revenue Division. In case of present Applicant, the Deputy Director of Land Records, Mumbai, will be the competent transferring authority. Learned Counsel has submitted that the said Notification is not published in the Government gazette as per requirement of Section 7 Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties, Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred as 'ROTA 2005' for brevity), though the transfer order is issued by the same authority.

(b) Husband of the Applicant has undergone open heart surgery in the year 2019 so the applicant's transfer is in contravention of Clause 6, Annexure 1 (page 44) of G.R. dated 09.04.2018.

(c) Non compliance of G.R. dated 09.04.2018 in view that though options were called out, but there was no counselling done in case of the Applicant.

4. During the course of arguments, it is found that the step of counselling as per G.R. of 09.04.2018 is omitted, so the Respondent is directed to take counselling of the Applicant today itself. Deputy Director, Old Customs House is directed to do counselling of the Applicant today itself by 2 p.m. The Applicant is directed to remain present in the said office.

5. Adjourned to 30.08.2024. Learned P.O. is directed to come with the report of counselling.
