2. This is an application made by the Applicant Smt. Manisha Kale (married sister of deceased Santosh) for appointment on compassionate ground. The deceased Santosh was Clerk-cum-Typist in G.T. Hospital, Mumbai. He died in harness on 09.10.2017 leaving behind his mother namely Smt. Ratan Pandharinath Dalvai and married sister Smt. Manisha Kale. Before his death, Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai dissolved the marriage between Santosh and his wife on 13.02.2017. It was divorced on mutual consent.

3. Smt. Ratan Dalvi (mother of deceased Santosh) made an application with the Respondents for appointment on compassionate ground on 03.11.2017. She had also supplied the copy of decree of divorce along with her application dated 24.11.2017. However till date, the Applicant did not get appointment on compassionate ground, and therefore, filed present O.A.

4. During the course of hearing, it is transpired that application dated 03.11.2017 has been processed by the Respondents and the Respondents seem to have formed opinion that Applicant is not entitled to appoint on compassionate ground, <sup>as</sup> ~~as~~ seen from file noting dated 03.02.2018 (Page No.38 of PB) which is obtained by the Applicant under Right to Information Act. It is really surprising that though the period of more than two years is over, till date there is no final order of communication which shows total inaction and laxity on the part of Respondents.

6. In view of above, Principal Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department is directed to file Affidavit as to why the decision on the application dated 03.11.2017 has not been communicated to the Applicant.

7. Affidavit should be filed within a week.
