Heard Shri Bhushan A. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Kranti Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents. 2. At the very outset, learned P.O. raised objection about maintainability of the O.A. without filing an application for condonation of delay of 4 years. 3. This is second round of litigation wherein the Applicant is again agitating the grievance of pay fixation. He stands retired on 31.05.2007 from the Government service from the post of Assistant Draftsman. 4. In the first round of litigation i.e. 412/2012, he sought re-fixation of pay in terms of G.R. dated 24.01.2007 in pay scale of Rs.5000-8000/- in the post of Assistant Draftsman and then in the pay scale of Rs.5,500-9000/- on the post of Draftsman. The O.A. was disposed of by order dated 03.02.2014. 5. Perusal of order in O.A.No.412/2012 reveals that submission was advanced by learned P.O. that the pay of the Applicant has already been fixed by order dated 31.03.2008 and it was acceptable to the Applicant. Accordingly, O.A. was disposed of with following order :- <i>"As the reliefs sought by the Applicant were already granted by order dated 31.03.2008, the O.A. stands disposed of with no order as to costs"</i> 6. Later, the Applicant has filed Contempt Application No.43/2015 which was disposed of on 08.09.2015 in following terms :- <i>"2. Learned P.O. Shri A.S. Wable appearing for the Respondents has tendered the copy of order passed by the Respondent No.1 dated 04.07.2015 on earlier date.</i> <p align="right">[P.T.O.]</p>

	<p>3. <i>Learned Advocate Shri B.A. Bandiwadekar appearing for the Applicant states that in view of that order, the direction contained in the order passed in O.A. is complied with. However, applicant may have to challenge that order.</i></p> <p>4. <i>Needless to observe that applicant is free to agitate the challenge.</i></p> <p>5. <i>In view of the compliance, this application is disposed of."</i></p> <p>7. The order dated 04.07.2015 rendered in above mentioned order is at Sr.No.49 of Paper Book of this O.A. By order dated 04.07.2015, it was communicated to the Applicant that pay scale granted to him is correct and the Applicant is accordingly received the pension since his retirement in 2007.</p> <p>8. It is on the above background, the present O.A. is again filed on 20.03.2019 seeking simply declaration that the Applicant be declared entitled to revise pay fixation in terms of G.R. dated 24.01.2007 without challenging the order dated 04.07.2015.</p> <p>9. Thus, what transpires from the record that the Applicant is agitating the same grievance in the present O.A. without challenging the order dated 04.07.2015.</p> <p>10. As stated above, the Applicant stands retired in 2007, first O.A.412/2012 was disposed of in 03.02.2014 and it was not challenged before higher forum. Apart, the order dated 04.07.2015 referred in Contempt Application order is also not challenged in the present O.A.. As such the question of limitation arises.</p> <p>11. O.A. ought to have been filed within one year from the order dated 04.07.2015 in terms of Section 21 of Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985. However, the present O.A. is filed on 20.03.2019 that too without challenging the order dated 04.07.2015 and without application for condonation of delay.</p> <p>12. In view of above, I find merit in the submission advanced by the learned P.O. that O.A. is hopelessly barred by limitation and it could not be entertained without filing of application for condonation of delay and condoning the delay, if sufficient ground is made out to condone the delay.</p> <p>13. The general statement made by the learned Counsel for the Applicant that it is a case of continuous cause of action can hardly be accepted without making an application for condonation of delay which is more than four years.</p> <p>14. In view of above, I have no hesitation to sum that O.A. itself is not maintainable being barred by limitation and deserves to be dismissed.</p> <p>15.
