ORDER

1. The order which is impugned in both the Original Applications is dated 15.10.2024. It reads as under:

"I am directed to refer to your letter No.GEN-2024/C.R.27/24/33 dated 03/10/2024, on the subject cited and to convey that SDO Purandar Smt. Varsha Landge is allowed to continue at present post and perform the election duties as RO/ERO of Purandar AC. However, Tehsildar Purandar Shri Vikram Rajput and SDPO Bhor Shri Tanaji Barade shall be kept out of election duties."

2. These Applicants and Smt. Varsha Landge who was then working as Deputy Collector / SDO, were placed under suspension on the allegation that they had committed lapses in making security arrangements of Electoral Voting Machines and VVPATs. It is not in dispute that all these three persons challenged their order of suspension before this Tribunal in O.A.Nos.205, 206 & 207 of 2024. These three Original Applications were decided by a common judgment dated 02.04.2024 by the Aurangabad Bench

of this Tribunal. While quashing and setting aside the impugned orders of suspension the Tribunal observed as follows:

"In my considered opinion, the Election Commission of India has hastily directed the Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra to suspend the applicants."

The Tribunal further observed,

"It appears that the Election Commission of India has issued suspension orders of the applicants for extraneous reasons by way of victimization. I agree with the submissions made on behalf of the applicants that the applicants have been made scapegoat in the entire process."

- 3. By order dated 22.04.2024 the directions were issued to reinstate Smt. Varsha Landge and both the applicants before this Tribunal, immediately.
- 4. It is also not in dispute that the Respondent No.1 subsequently decided to drop the proposed Departmental action against Smt. Varsha Landge as well as both the Applicants before this Tribunal. On the basis of these undisputed facts it was submitted that the impugned order is malafide and discriminatory.
- 5. The impugned order has made an exception by allowing Smt. Varsha Landge to continue on her present post and perform the Election duties as RO/ERO of Purandar AC. It was submitted by learned Counsel for the Applicants that allegations against Smt. Varsha Landge and these two Applicants were identical and hence there was absolutely no reason to treat them differently. It is also not in dispute that during the Elections to Lok Sabha, Smt. Varsha Landge as well as both these Applicants were allotted Election Duty but at the stage of counting of votes they were directed to keep away from Election Duty for one day i.e. on 04.06.2024.
- 6. In addition to raising the ground of discrimination the Applicants have contended that the impugned order is stigmatic. It is pointed out that the impugned order refers to communication dated 03.10.2024 which formed

the basis therefor. Copy of this communication is not annexed to reply of Respondents No.4 and 5.

- 7. The directives issued by the Election Commission of India dated 31.07.2024 inter alia state:
 - "(iv) It is further directed that the officers/officials against whom the Commission had recommended disciplinary action in past and which is pending or which has resulted in a penalty or the officers who have been charged for any lapse in any election or election related work in the past, shall not be assigned any election related duty. However, an officer who was transferred during any past election under the Commission's order without any recommendation of disciplinary actions will not be, just on this ground, considered for transfer, unless specifically so directed by the Commission. A copy of the Commission's instruction number 464/INST/2008-EPS dated 23^{rd} December 2008 regarding tracking of names of tainted officers is enclosed. CEOs must ensure its compliance."
- 8. It was submitted by learned Counsel for the Applicants that none of the contingencies stipulated in Clause (iv) was attracted in the case of the Applicants. The disciplinary action which was contemplated against the applicants was subsequently dropped. It is not the case of Respondents No.4 and 5 that any point of time penalty was imposed on them. It was submitted that the words in "or the officers who have been charged for any lapse in any election or election related work in the past, shall not be assigned any election related duty" are required to be interpreted keeping in view the facts of this case. It may be reiterated that the contemplated Departmental action against the applicants was dropped. They were not penalized on any previous occasion. Therefore, prima facie, this particular contingency, in our opinion, was not attracted.
- 9. It was submitted by learned Counsel for Respondents No.4 and 5 that allotment of Election related duties is a prerogative of Election Commission of India and no person can claim it as a matter of right. The applicants are primarily seeking interim relief in the nature of stay to the effect and implementation of the impugned order on the ground that the impugned order, unless it is stayed, will operate as stigma. Respondents No.4 and 5 seek to rely on judgment dated 29.03.2019 passed by the **Hon'ble High**

Court of Andhra Pradesh in I.A.No.2/2019 in Writ Petition No.4376/2019, The State of Andhra Pradesh Vs. Election Commission of India & Anr. In the case before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh an order which was styled as one of transfer was impugned. Keeping in view the facts of the case, the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh observed,

"The apprehension of the applicants that in the eye of the public or otherwise, it may amount to stigma, is without any substance. The impugned order does not cast any stigma on the applicant. Once the election process is over, they will be reverted back to their original position and therefore they cannot have any grievance whatsoever."

- 10. In the instant case, on facts, we have come to the conclusion that the impugned order, prima facie, is stigmatic in nature. We have, therefore, come to the conclusion that the effect and implementation of order dated 15.10.2024 is required to be stayed till next date. It is, accordingly stayed till the next date.
- 11. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 12. Issue notice before admission returnable on 26.11.2024.
- 13. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 14. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 15. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

16. In case notice is not collected within <u>seven</u> days or service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three</u> days before returnable date, the Original Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Bench under the caption "for Dismissal" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original Application shall stand dismissed.

Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

- 2. By order dated 8.2.2022 (Annexure A-2) the applicant was transferred from Wadgaon Nimbalkar Police Station to Headquarter. By order dated 16.1.2024 (Annexure A-5) the applicant was transferred to Upper Baramati.
- 3. By order dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure A-4) the applicant shown to have been transferred from Upper Baramati to Supa. By order dated 12.10.2024 (Annexure A-1) the applicant was transferred from Upper Baramati to Headquarter.
- 4. First grievance of the applicant is that he was unjustifiably subjected to frequent transfers.
- 5. According to the Ld. PO the post at Upper Baramathi was not sanctioned and therefore the impugned order was issued. His further submission is that by passing the impugned order error committed at the time of issuing order dated 10.10.2024 in respect of the applicant was sought to be corrected. It is submitted that if this was indeed the case these details should have been mentioned in the impugned order but these details are not there.
- 6. On all these grounds interim relief in the nature of stay to the effect and implementation of the impugned order to the extent of the applicant is sought. This is preliminarily opposed by the Ld. PO on the ground the applicant has not joined on the transferred post.
- 7. On considering rival submissions, I have come to the conclusion that case is made out to pass the interim order.
- 8. The effect and implementation of the impugned order to the extent of the applicant shall stand stayed till the next date. The applicant shall be permitted to work on the post at Upper Baramati.
