- 2. There is a delay of 2 years and 7 months caused in filing the accompanying Original Application.
- 3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants came to be appointed in the Home Department and they had worked at various Police Stations under the control of the respondents. All the applicants retired form service on different dates in between 2017 to 2022. During that period, after retirement the respondent No.2 has directed to recover the amount on account of excess payment made to the applicants towards pay and allowances. However, no recovery orders have been issued by the respondent No.2 to the applicants.
- 4. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have personally approached to

the office of respondent No.2 for refund of the recovered amount from their retirement benefits. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the principle laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case <u>State of Punjab & Ors. Vs. Rafiq Masih</u> (White Washer) reported in 2015 (4) SCC 334 is squarely applicable to the case of the applicants and even though the Special Inspector General of Police by communication dated 05.09.2018 directed not to recover the amount and take necessary action for refund of the amount, the respondents have not refunded the said amount to the applicants. There is no inaction on the part of the applicants and there is no intentional or deliberately delay in approaching this Tribunal.

5. Learned Presenting Officer has strongly resisted the application for the reason that there is an inordinate delay in approaching this Tribunal for which no satisfactory explanation has been tendered. Learned P.O. submits that the applicants came to be retired on different dates and the recovery on account of excess amount paid to them has been made from their retirement benefits. There

is no substance in this Original Application and the same is liable to be rejected.

It appears that the applicant Nos. 1,2,4,5 & 7 6. to 12 are the Assistant Sub Inspectors falling in Class-III employees and applicant Nos. 3 & 6 are the Head Constable falling in Class-IV employees. appears that the ratio laid down in the case State of Punjab & Ors. Vs. Rafiq Masih, prima-facie, is squarely applicable to the case of applicants and as such, the recovery is not permissible. There is no inaction on the part of the applicants and there is no intentional and deliberately delay. The applicants have approached the respondent authorities for refund of the amount in terms of communication issued by the Special Inspector General of Police in this regard. Thus, considering the entire facts of the case, I am inclined to condone the delay subject to some costs. Hence, the following order:-

#### ORDER

The Misc. Application No. 371/2023 is allowed in following terms:-

(A) The delay of 2 years and 7 months caused in filing the accompanying O.A.

under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 is hereby condoned subject to costs of Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred only) per applicant. The amount of costs to be paid to the Bar Association, MAT and after depositing the said amount, the applicant shall produce the receipt before the office of this Tribunal.

(B) Upon satisfaction of the costs as above, the accompanying O.A. be registered and numbered by taking in to account other office objection/s, if any.

transfer and posting orders have been passed frequently on the basis of telephonic message without constituting Civil Service Board and without any recommendations by the said Board. Learned counsel submits that it is not necessary to state that in moving of the Government employee even by way of deputation is amounting to transfer.

- 3. These applicants are seeking benefit under Government Resolution dated 29.11.1984. Under the said G.R. benefit of counting the service

rendered on the post of Jr. Engineer/Sectional Engineer is admissible while granting deemed date of absorption in the cadre of Assistant Engineers of (Electrical) upon acquisition degree in Engineering. The provisions under the said G.R. were superseded with the publication of the Recruitment Rules of 2009, which was notified in the official gazette dated 16.05.2009. The candidates who secured degree of Engineering before coming into force of the Recruitment Rules of 2009 were held entitled for the benefit under G.R. dated 29.11.1984. The applicants in the present matters have undisputedly secured degree of Engineering after coming into force of the Recruitment Rules, 2009. In the circumstances, the applicants cannot be held entitled for the benefit under G.R. dated 29.11.1984.

4. The Hon'ble Bombay High Court has dismissed the Writ Petition No. 5851/2023 with the same observations that the scheme of grant of additional weightage under the G.R. dated 29.11.1984 would come to end after promulgation of Rules.
