Aggrieved by the order dated 11.08.2023 2. whereby the Government has suspended the applicant from services is questioned in the present Original Application. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the order though is stated to have been passed by invoking the powers under Rule 4(1) (a) of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1979, it is no where stated or indicated that the disciplinary proceeding against the applicant is contemplated or is pending. further Learned counsel submitted that compliance of the assurance given by the Hon'ble Revenue Minister in the Assembly on 23.08.2022 i.e. almost a year before the impugned order has been passed. The learned counsel in the circumstances has prayed for staying the effect and operation of the

impugned order while issuing notices to the respondents in the matter.

- 3. Learned C.P.O. has opposed for granting any interim relief. Learned C.P.O. submitted that when it has been clarified in the order itself that the impugned order is passed by invoking the powers under Rule 4 (1) (a), it has to be read in the order that the enquiry is contemplated against the applicant. Learned C.P.O. hence opposed for grant of any interim relief as has been prayed by the applicant and sought time to file the affidavit in reply on behalf of the respondents.
- 4. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant as well as the State authorities. I have also perused the impugned order. It is true that in the order it has been stated that the applicant is being placed under suspension under the provisions of Rule 4(1) (a) of M.C.S. (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1979. However, it has to be stated that it is no where disclosed by the respondents that the disciplinary proceeding is contemplated or pending against the present applicant. I deem it

appropriate to reproduce Rule 4 hereinbelow which reads thus:-

- **"4. Suspension.-** (1) The appointing authority or any authority to which the appointing authority is subordinate or the disciplinary authority or any other authority empowered in the behalf by the Governor by general or special order may place a Government servant under suspension-
 - (a) where a disciplinary proceeding against him in contemplated or is pending, or
 - (b) where in the opinion of the authority aforesaid, he has engaged himself in activities prejudicial to the interest of the security of the State, or
 - (c) where a case against him in respect of any criminal offence is under investigation, inquiry or trial:

Provided that, where the order of suspension is made by an authority lower than the appointing authority, such authority shall forthwith report to the appointing authority, the circumstances in which the order was made."

5. The plain reading of aforesaid Rule would make it clear that the power under Rule 4(1) (a) can be exercised by the State authorities only in

the case where enquiry is contemplated against the Government servant or is pending against the Government servant. In the present matter, respondents have not disclosed in the impugned order whether the disciplinary proceeding is contemplated or pending against the applicant. In the circumstances, the applicant has certainly made out a case for grant of interim relief as has been prayed. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 11.09.2023. Till then the order dated 11.08.2023 shall stand suspended. It is clarified that the Government is not precluded from issuing fresh order by following the due procedure under Rule 4 of M.C.S. (D & A) Rules, 1979.
- (ii) Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

The applicant had applied for the post of Assistant Commissioner (Drugs), Food and Drugs Administrative Services, Group-A in pursuance of the advertisement no. 020/2022 published in that regard on 19.3.2022. The applicant claims to be possessing qualification, as well as, experience as prescribed for the subject post in the said advertisement. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant appeared for the screening test and has passed the said test. His name was, therefore, included in the list of 'qualified candidates'. Subsequently the applicant has been declared not eligible on the ground that he does not

possess the requisite experience as required in the advertisement. It is the contention of the applicant that he is possessing the requisite experience and all the documents in that regard were uploaded while submitting online application. Learned counsel submitted that all these documents are also placed on record in the O.A. He took me through the said Learned counsel submitted that the documents. decision of the respondents to place the applicant in the list of 'not eligible candidates' is prima-facie erroneous. Learned counsel submitted that the interviews of the candidates, whose names are included in the list of 'eligible candidates' are going to be held on 31.8.2023 and 1.9.2023. Learned counsel, in the circumstances, prayed for an interim relief, thereby directing the MPSC to call the applicant also for the interview, subject to outcome of the present O.A. Learned counsel submitted that, if the applicant is not allowed to appear for the interview, irreparable loss would be caused to him of getting selected for the subject post.

3. Learned Chief Presenting Officer has opposed for granting of any such relief. Learned CPO sought

time to file the affidavit in reply on behalf of the respondents. Learned CPO submitted that for lack of instructions from the respondents he is unable to make any statement as about the correctness of the facts stated by the applicant in his O.A. Learned CPO submitted that if appropriate time is provided, the respondents will file their detailed affidavit in reply clarifying the factual aspects.

- 4. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, as well as, the respondent authorities. I have also perused the documents on record. Clause 8.1 of the advertisement deals with the educational qualification, whereas clause 8.2 prescribes the experience required for appointment on the subject post. Since the candidate has been included in the list of 'not eligible' candidates allegedly for want of the requisite experience, I deem it appropriate to reproduce clauses 8.1 and clause 8.2, which read thus:-
- "८.9) शेक्षणिक अर्हता Possess a degree in Pharmacy or Pharmaceutical Chemistry or Degree in Pharmacology with specialization in Clinical Pharmacology or Microbiology from a recognized University established in India by Law; AND

- ८.२) अनुभव Possess experience, gained after acquiring above 8.1 qualification, in the manufacture or testing of drugs or enforcement of the provisions of the Act for a minimum period of five years."
- 5. Copies of the experience certificates, which were uploaded by the applicant are also filed along with the present O.A. From the said certificates it prima-facie, appears that the applicant was holding the requisite experience prescribed for the subject post. In the circumstances, the applicant has certainly made out a prima-facie case for grant of interim relief as has been prayed by him. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- 1. Issue notice to respondents, returnable on 3.10.2023.
- 2. The MPSC (respondent No. 3) is directed to issue a call letter to the applicant and interview him.
- 3. It is clarified that the result of the interview of the applicant shall be subject to outcome of the present Original Application.

- "C) Pending hearing and final disposal of this Original Application may kindly be stayed the qualified list of candidates dated 20.07.2023 from the common screening test or examination for the post of Gr. "A" and Gr. "B" and the interview call letter dated 22 August 2023 for the qualified candidates from the Common Screening test or examination for the post of Gr. "A" and Gr. "B"."
- 4. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that when there were 2 different advertisements for 2 different posts and when syllabus was also different, the respondents could not have taken a common screening test for both the aforesaid posts. Learned counsel, therefore, has prayed for grant of interim relief as has been prayed vide clause (C) in the prayer clauses of the O.A. Learned counsel submitted that because of the patent mistake committed by the respondents, the applicant has been prejudicially affected and has lost the chance of his selection.
- 5. Learned Chief Presenting Officer submitted that a common screening test was held in the month of January, 2023 and the applicant had appeared for the said screening test without raising any

objection therefor. Learned CPO submits that, in the circumstances, the applicant does not have any right to challenge the said process after having participated therein.

6. I find substance in the contention as has been raised by the learned CPO. On a query made by the Tribunal whether the applicant has raised any objection before appearing for the screening test, the learned counsel has fairly submitted that no such objection was raised by the applicant before appearing for the screening In the test. circumstances, it does not appear to me that any case has been made out by the applicant for grant of interim relief as has been prayed by him. Hence, I pass the following order:-

In the circumstances, the application so filed is apparently not maintainable at the instance of the applicant. The objection raised by the office is, therefore, sustained and the registration of the O.A. is refused.
- 4. At this juncture, the learned counsel for the applicant, on instructions, sought leave to withdraw the present O.A. for filing it at the appropriate forum. Hence, the following order:-

- 2. The present Misc. Applications are filed by the applicants for condonation of delay caused in filing the accompanying O.As.
- 3. The applicants in their respective O.As. have prayed for subsistence allowance at the rate equal to which was being paid before the order of conviction passed against them. Relying on the Government Circular dated 27.07.1984 it is the contention of all these applicants in the present M.As. that they were

unaware of the aforesaid Circular and that is the reason why they did not prefer any claim for their subsistence allowance prior to 20.07.2021.

- 4. Learned counsel appearing for the applicants submitted that the delay caused in preferring the O.As. is unintentional and without any mala-fide.
- 5. The respondents have opposed the Misc. Applications by submitting their affidavits in reply. Learned P.O. submitted that there is no sufficient cause for condoning delay, which is of huge delay of more than 10 years. Learned P.O. submitted that in fact after the applicants were convicted, they seize to be employees of the State. As such, according to the respondents, the Misc. Applications itself may not be entertainable, when the termination order has not been challenged.
- 6. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicants, as well as, the respondents. I have also gone through the documents placed on record. The applicants are praying for subsistence allowance of the period after

the date of their conviction till their retirement on the basis of the Government Circular referred hereinabove. The appeals filed by the applicants against the orders of conviction are still pending. In approaching Tribunal late, there appears no illintension on part of the applicants. As such, it appears to me that the applicants must be given an opportunity to prosecute their matters on merit. I am, therefore, inclined to allow the present Misc. Applications. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) All these M.As. are allowed.
- (ii) The delay caused in filing the accompanying O.As. is condoned.
- (iii) Accompanying O.As. be registered and numbered in accordance with law.
- (iv) The M.As. stand disposed of. No order as to costs.
