1. Shri K. R. Jagdale, learned Advocate for Applicants-Interveners (Respondent Nos.4 and 5) in M.A. and for Respondent Nos.4, 5, 6 in O.A. Shri A. S. Raktade, learned Advocate for Respondents (Ori. Applicants) and Shri A. Y. Sakhare, learned Special Counsel with Smt. Kranti Gaikwad, learned P.O. for Respondent Nos. 8, 9 & 10.
2. Shri K. R. Jagdale, learned Advocate has filed MA for intervention in the above O.A. and prayed for 'vacating stay' granted by this Tribunal on 22.12.2023 directing that no orders of appointment are to be issued against 436 'Female' posts.
3. Learned Advocate for the Applicants submits that Advertisement No.1/2022 came to be published by Respondent No.9-Director of Vocational Education & Training' on 17.08.2022 for various posts of 'Craft Instructors' in the Industrial Training Institutes. Out of which 436 posts are reserved for Female. The 'Provisional Select List' was published on 06.10.2023. In the said 'Provisional Select List', 7 female candidates from 'Open' category who opted 'Yes' for 'LDS' female reservation have approached this Tribunal challenging arbitrary method adopted by Respondent No.2 for applying 'LDS Female Reservation' to such female candidates who did not opt 'Yes' for 'LDS Female Reservation' while submitting their Online Examination Forms.
4. Shri A. Y. Sakhare, learned Special Counsel along with Smt. Kranti Gaikwad, learned P.O. for Respondent Nos.8, 9 & 10 relied on 'Affidavit in Reply' filed by Shri Diganbar Ambadas Dalvi, Director in the office of Directorate of Vocational Educational and Training, Mumbai on 09.01.2024.

Learned Senior Counsel points out Para 6 of 'Affidavit in Reply' where Chart of the selection of female candidates of all categories is shown and also clarified the option pertained to the candidates belonging to 'Open Female Category' opting preference of 'Yes' or 'No' for the post reserved for Female.

5. Learned Senior Counsel for Respondents further points out that at Sr. 10 of Chart mentioned in Affidavit in Reply, total 1455 'Female candidates from 'Open' categories are shown to be appeared. Out of them, 663 candidates opted 'Yes' and 792 Female Candidates have opted 'No' for the post reserved for ladies. Learned Counsel in support of his submission makes statement at Bar on the basis of instructions from Shri Anil Gavit, Joint Director from the office of Respondent No.2 that 'Open' Female Candidates who have not opted for 'LDS' reservation are not given the benefit of reservation in 'Female Category'.

6. We call upon Senior Counsel for Respondents to file short Affidavit in view of statement on behalf of Respondent No.2.

7. As per oral direction of this Tribunal, short Affidavit filed by Respondent No.2. It is taken on record.

8. Shri K. R. Jagdale, learned Counsel for the Applicants (Ori. Respondents Nos.4 & 5) submits that Ms Chaitali Aher is from 'OBC' category and Ms Rekha Kuri is from 'NT-B' category. He states that because of stay granted by this tribunal by order dated 22.12.2023, the entire process in filling up the posts in 'Female Category' is withheld. Therefore, he prays to vacate the stay granted by this Tribunal on 22.12.2023.

9. In view of above, prima-facie, we do not find any merit in favour of the Applicants and thus vacate the stay which was granted by this tribunal in order dated 22.12.2023. We further direct the Original Respondent Nos.1 to 3 to proceed with select list and appointment of 'Female Candidates' in all categories.

10. Learned Counsel for Original Applicants seeks short time to take instructions.

2. Learned PO produces the letter of the 'District Superintendent of Land Records, Navi Mumbai', dated 29.01.2024, wherein it is stated that draft 'Parawise Comments' have been submitted for approval of 'Settlement Commissioner Director of Land Records, Pune'. Learned PO therefore seeks 'One Week' time to file 'Affidavit-in-Reply' on behalf of Respondent No.2 who is 'Settlement Commissioner Director of Land Records, Pune'.

Learned PO therefore to seek information from 'Additional Chief Secretary (Revenue), Revenue and Forest Department, Mumbai' as to why Applicant who is 'Physically Handicapped' to extent of 48% due to affliction of 'Polio' and thus entitled to 'Reasonable Accommodation' under 'Section 2 (y) & Section 20 (2) of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016' was not given exemption under 'Rule 7' of the Maharashtra Government Allotment of Revenue Divisions for appointment by nomination and promotion to the posts in Group A and Group B (Gazetted and Non-Gazetted) Rules, 2021.

Learned C.P.O. on being asked about number of 'Daily Wagers' working in Sanjay Gandhi National Park, Borivali who were appointed after 2004 and upto Revenue and Forest Department dated 16.10.2012 said that the figure of such 'Daily Wagers' was 79. Further, the number of 'Daily Wagers' working in Sanjay Gandhi National Park, Borivali who were appointed after Revenue and Forest Department GR dated 16.10.2012 and working till date, the figure of such 'Daily Wagers' is 236.(including 11 + 79).

5. Learned Counsel for the Applicants submits the fact that Applicants are holding a 'Certificate' of completion of 5 years with 240 days per year service. He states that Applicant No.1 working as 'Daily Wage Forest Labour' in the Department of Forest since 2006 and Applicant No.2 is working since 2009.
