Bhosle, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B. K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents finally at the stage of admission. 2. In this O.A., the Applicant has raised grievance though she stands retired on 13.04.2022 (voluntary retirement). She is not paid her retiral benefits despite her representation and persuasion to the department. She, therefore, constrained to file present O.A. for retiral benefits with interest. 3. Indisputably, there was no legal hurdle to release retiral benefits when request of the Applicant for voluntary retirement was accepted by the department. In this behalf, Government order dated 22.03.2022 clearly states that there was neither D.E. nor criminal prosecution was pending against him. As such, there was no legal hurdle to withhold retiral benefits but those are not paid though the period of near about 1 year is over. 4. In Affidavit in Reply all that respondents submits that several service books were pending for verification and, therefore, it took time. 5. During the pendency of O.A., the Applicant paid G.P.F. of Rs.23,26,207/- which she received on 01.03.2023 and also paid GIS of Rs.81,548/- which was received by her on 23.03.2023 However, remaining retirement benefits i.e. pension, gratuity and leave encashment is not yet paid even provisional pension is not paid.

6. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that she is reserving her claim for grant of interest on belated payment and O.A. be disposed of with directions to Respondents to release her remaining retiral benefits immediately.

7. Since, the voluntary retirement notice is accepted and there was no legal hurdle to release retiral benefits, the Applicant is deprived of her legitimate dues for long period. It is only after filing of O.A., the Respondents have initiated steps to process the matter. As such, there are administrative lapses on the part of Respondents for not releasing retiral benefits within stipulated period.

8. In view of above, the O.A. is disposed of with following directions :-

- (A) The Respondents' are directed to release gratuity, pension and leave encashment within a months from today.
- (B) The Applicant is at liberty to redress the grievance of interest independently.

9. No order as to costs.


