Heard Shri M.D. Lonkar &amp; Shri S.S. Dere, learned Advocates for the Applicants and Shri A.J. Chougule, Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, Smt. Archana B.K., Shri A.D. Gugale and Shri D.R. Patil learned Presenting Officers for Respondents.</p> <p>2. Learned Advocate for Applicants states that 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' has recently initiated the process for 'General Transfers: 2024' which are likely to happen after 'General Election Lok Sabha: 2024'.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant stressed that if transfers of 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' Order dated 26.02.2024 effected as per directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023 and subsequent clarifications issued by letters dated on '18.01.2024 &amp; 24.01.2024 are not upheld upon consideration of all aspects of law and judicial pronouncements then adequate posts of 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' must be kept available for Applicants in batch O.A. No.260/2024 &amp; Others to join back at their earlier places of postings in respective 'Police Establishments'.</p>

4. The 'Police Personnel' who have challenged their transfers in present batch of O.A. No.260/2024 & Others are 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' but several others have also been filed by 'Police Inspectors' under 'Section 19' of 'Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985'.

5. The directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023 are to transfer 'Government Servants' including 'Police Personnel'; who are directly connected with 'General Elections Lok Sabha: 2024' on grounds of having completed '3 Years' in the district during last '4 Years' or being posted in 'Home Districts'.

6. The directions of 'Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023' for transfer of 'Government Servants' including 'Police Personnel' thus are distinct from the criteria adopted for transfers of (a) 'Government Servants' under 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' and (b) 'Police Personnel' under 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'.

7. The criteria for transfer of 'Government Servants' with certain exceptions is completion of 'Normal Tenure' of '3 Years' as per provisions of 'Section 3(1)(a)' of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'; while criteria for transfer of 'Police Personnel' with specific exceptions is completion of 'Normal Tenure' ranging from '2 Years' upto '8 Years' as per provisions of 'Section 22(N)(1)' of the 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'. Further it is pertinent to note that both these 'State Legislations' do not place any restrictions on transfer of 'Government Servant' or 'Police Personnel' in their 'Home Districts'.

8. The batch of O.A. No.260/2024 & Others relate to transfer of 'Police Personnel' who are 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.'; thus it is imperative to further elucidate nuanced differences in structures of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' which governs transfers of all 'Police Personnel' and 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' which regulates transfers of all other 'Government Servants'.

	<p>9. The 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' under 'Section 22N(1)' does not provide uniform 'Normal Tenure' of '3 Years' to all 'Police Personnel'. While it extends upto '5 Years' for 'Police Constables'; it can vary from '2 Years to 3 Years' if 'Police Personnel' such as 'P.S.I.'; 'A.P.I.' and Police Inspectors' are serving at 'Police Station' or 'Crime Branch' or 'Special Branch' under 'Commissioners of Police' and 'Superintendents of Police' or if they are serving in any 'Specialized Agency'. Interestingly the law even provides for aggregation through 'Cumulative Tenures' from '4 Years' upto '8 Years' within 'District' or 'Range' and 'Commissionerate'. Hence, distinguishing feature of 'Section 22N(1) of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' is that tenures of 'Police Personnel' can vary based on the post they occupy; even if they are of equal rank and serving within same 'Police Establishment'.</p> <p>10. The batch of O.A. No.260/2024 and Others filed by 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' and those filed separately by 'Police Inspectors' would have to be eventually adjudicated after 'General Elections Lok Sabha: 2024'. The legal entitlement of tenures of 'Police Personnel' under 'Section 22(N)(1) of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' which is 'State Legislation' have not been extirpated just because transfers have been effected as per directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023 although based on decisions taken by 'P.E.B.' with 'Transfer Orders' issued with due approval of 'Competent Authority' under 'Section 22N(1)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'. Important dimension of such transfers of 'Police Personnel' is that many have been effected as per directions in 'Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023' only on grounds of 'Home District' and much prior to completion of their 'Normal Tenures' of '2 Years' to '8 Years'; notwithstanding the fact that 'Competent Authority' are still empowered to transfer 'Police Personnel' in exceptional cases in 'Public Interest' or on grounds of 'Administrative Exigencies' under 'Section 22(N)(2)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'.</p>

Naturally therefore 'ad-rem' question of law arises whether enforcement of directions of 'Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023' for 'General Elections Lok Sabha: 2024' are to be considered as those included in category of 'Exceptional Cases' when transfers orders of 'Police Personnel' can be issued in 'Public Interest' or on grounds of 'Administrative Exigencies'.

11. The 'Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department' is therefore informed to refer to observations made in following judgments of 'Hon'ble Bombay High Court' which have delved into issues relating to transfers of 'Government Servants' and 'Police Personnel' as per extant directions of 'State Election Commission' which are generally similar to those of 'Election Commission of India'.

12. The 'Hon'ble Bombay High Court' in Judgment dated 04.04.2018 in Writ Petition No. 6041 of 2017 & Others has observed the following:-

(i) *"The petitioners and others were transferred on consideration of guidelines/directives of the State Election Commission and in view of the initiation of process of election for local authorities and since the purpose for which they were shifted before completion of their normal tenure, is already over and the process of election has come to an end long back, it would be open for the State to pass appropriate orders of transfer for reposting them at an appropriate place, in observance of the procedure prescribed under the Transfer Act."*

(ii) *"Apart from this, it also deserves to be considered that the orders of transfer have been given effect more than a year back and any interference, at this stage, would amount to displacement of several employees thereby creating difficulties in the administration. The orders of transfer are expected to be issued considering the administrative exigencies. However, as has been noted above, interference at this stage, would, instead of, protecting interest of the administration, would created difficulties, as has been canvassed by the State. In this view of the matter and for the reasons recorded above, according to us, orders passed by the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, directing to quash the orders of transfer under the impugned judgment and order dated 24.04.2017, deserves to be quashed and set aside and same is accordingly quashed and set aside. It is, however, made clear that it would be open for the State to pass appropriate orders transferring the employees, if deemed necessary for administrative exigencies while effecting regular process in the months of April-May, 2018"*

The 'Hon'ble Bombay High Court' in its Judgment dated 07.12.2016 in Writ Petition No. 9499 of 2016 has observed the following:-</p> <p><i>(i) "It is likely that in some cases, some inconvenience could be caused to the employees who had been transferred due to holding of elections in a particular district or local area, but keeping in view the larger public interest, if the State Election Commissioner had taken a decision, the State Government would implement the same keeping in view constitutional intent and spirit and for holding free and fair elections. It is informed that in the State of Maharashtra, election process relating to elections of Corporations, Councils, Panchayats, Zilla Parishad, Village Panchayat is already set in motion".</i></p> <p><i>(ii) "The State Government and the State Election Commissioner are free to contemplate on the issue of transfer of officers keeping in view various aspects for consideration and frame a proper policy for future with sole objective of holding free and fair election".</i></p> <p>14. The 'Hon'ble Bombay High Court' in Judgments cited above have not only highlighted the transient character of such transfers which are often done in observance of directions given by 'State Election Commission' or 'Election Commission of India' but more importantly they have specifically emphasized about necessity to frame separate policy for such transfers. However, no information about formulation of any separate policy has thus far been submitted on behalf of 'Additional Chief Secretary Home Department' or 'D.G.P Maharashtra State'.</p> <p>15. The indulgence of 'Additional Chief Secretary Home Department' as 'Chairperson' and 'D.G.P Maharashtra State' as 'Vice-Chairperson' of 'P.E.B. No.1' as constituted under 'Section 22C(2)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' is therefore sought to resolve the grievances of all 'Police Personnel' who are Applicants about their transfers based only on directions in Election Commission of India letter dated</p>

21.12.2023 and subsequent clarifications issued by letters dated on 18.01.2024 & 24.01.2024 because provisions of 'Section 22D(1)' empowers 'P.E.B. No.1' to make appropriate recommendations to 'State Government' regarding 'Service Conditions' of 'Police Officers' excluding 'Salary Allowances'; while 'Section 22D (2)' specifically assigns 'P.E.B. 1' with distinct role to advise and make recommendations to 'State Government' regarding 'Postings' and 'Transfers' of 'Police Officers' even emphasizing that 'State Government' shall give due weightage to its recommendations. Hence, against backdrop of vast powers vested with 'P.E.B 1' under 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' and upon considering on one hand that implementation of directions of 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 will have cascading effect in near future with its outreach going beyond 'General Elections Lok Sabha 2024' upto 'General Elections of Maharashtra Legislative Assembly: 2024' and possibly at time of 'General Elections' to 'Urban & Rural Bodies' when conducted in by 'State Election Commission'; and on the other hand the necessity to diligently carry out fair assessment of overall impact on 'Public Exchequer' as well as other 'Administrative Exigencies', if such transfers were to be modified or changed or even set aside in 'Judicial Review', it is imperative to subject this entire issue to indepth deliberations at the level of 'P.E.B.-1'. Hence, the 'Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department' as 'Chairperson' of 'P.E.B-1' is informed to expeditiously convene 'Special Meeting' to consider all the detailed observations made above and upon due approval by 'State Government' of its considered recommendations as contemplated under 'Section 22D(2)(a)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' propose what appropriate course of action could be taken to redress grievances of such 'Police Personnel' from rank of 'Police Inspector'; 'A.P.I.' and 'P.S.I.' who have challenged their transfers by invoking 'Section 19' of the 'Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.'

16. The 'General Transfer 2024' of 'Police Personnel' may be done after 'General Elections Lok Sabha: 2024'. Further as several posts of 'Police Inspectors', 'A.P.I.' and 'P.S.I.' may be vacant especially in the 'Functional Departments' which have been identified by 'Home Department' Circular dated 16.02.2009 thus till such time as 'Affidavits-in-Reply' as expected are filed on behalf of 'Additional Chief Secretary Home Department' and 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'

No.287/2024 states that Applicants had already been transferred to posts in 'Functional Department' by 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri Chinchwad' Order dated 13.01.2024 and therefore were not required to be transferred again by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' Order dated 26.02.2024.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant stated that 'M.A.T. Aurangabad Bench' by its Judgment in O.A. No.217/2024 dated 21.03.2024 has taken view that if 'Police Personnel' had recently been transferred to posts in 'Functional Department' as is the case of present Applicants in O.A. No.284/2024 &amp; O.A. No.287/2024; then there was no justification to transfer them again as per directions in 'Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023'. The 'M.A.T. Aurangabad Bench' granted prayers of Applicants in O.A. No.217/2024 and set aside 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' Order dated 26.02.2024 qua the Applicants.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicants in O.A. No.284/2024 &amp; O.A. No.287/2024 thereupon presented few Judgments of 'Hon'ble Supreme Court of India' to emphasize about observance of Judgments passed by 'Co-ordinate Bench' of (a) 'Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT)' (b) 'Armed Forces Tribunal (AFT)'.</p> <p>5. Learned Advocate for Applicant upon query about if there was any reference date for effecting transfers of 'Police Personnel' and whether such reference date could even be different for (i) 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' (ii) 'Commissioners of Police' and</p>

(iii) 'Superintendents of Police'; explained that there was no reference date as such because nothing has been mentioned in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023. The transfers of 'Police Personnel' were thus required to be completed by 31.01.2024; before submission of 'Compliance Reports' by respective 'Chief Secretary' and 'D.G.P.'.

6. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon stated that as per judgment of 'M.A.T. Aurangabad Bench' in O.A. No.217/2024 dated 21.03.2024 and considering that transfer of Applicants had been effected before 31.01.2024 by 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri Chinchwad' 'Transfer Order' dated 13.01.2024 which was as per 'Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023'; the Applicants should have been permitted to continue on their posts in 'Functional Departments' instead of being transferred again by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' Order dated 26.02.2024.

7. Learned Advocate for Applicant also drew attention to contents of 'Home Department' Circular dated 16.02.2009 which encloses list of 'Specialized Agencies' as well as names of 'Special Branches' in establishments of (a) Commissioners of Police & (b) 'Superintendents of Police' which had been classified into 'Functional Department' for granting exemption from transfers to all 'Police Personnel'.

8. Learned Advocate for Applicant stated that it was also pertinent to note that it has not been brought to knowledge of 'Chief Secretary' or 'Additional Chief Secretary Home Department' & 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' that they had not implemented the directions of 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 with respect to transfers of 'Police Personnel'.

9. Learned P.O. seeks time of atleast 'Four Weeks' to obtain detailed information from 'Additional Chief Secretary Home Department & 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'; so as to file 'Affidavit-in-Reply' in O.A. No.284/2024 and O.A. No.287/2024.




6. The issue before this Tribunal is about the legality of the promotions given to the ad hoc promotees whose name are mentioned in Annexure B. Annexure-B cannot be dissected and some of them cannot be given different treatment. Hence, the issue is to be decided finally without vacating stay qua interveners.

7. Smt. Punam Mahajan, Ld. Advocate for Respondents No.24, 26, 41, 42 & 90 submits that she has no objection to vacating the interim order qua the interveners.

8. In this matter the Government has regularized the fortuitous ad hoc promotion on 3.1.2015 w.e.f. 1.1.2017 onwards.

9. Ld. Advocate for the applicants has furnished his submissions, Ld. PO is partly heard and Ld. Advocate for private respondent is to yet begin.

10. Considering this stage we made query to the Government as to what is the stage of promotions to the post of Dy. Secretary which the State intends to issue. Ld. PO on instructions inform that DPC for the post of Dy. Secretary is held on 15.4.2024 and the file is pending with the concerned Section Officer of GAD and it will take approximately two months' time for issuance of orders. Our earlier order dated 18.4.2024 reads as under:

*"2. As the matter is subjudice and in order to avoid further complications, we direct the respondents not to issue orders of promotion to the post of Deputy Secretary without the permission of the Court."*

11. Considering this we clarify our earlier order dated 18.4.2024. It means that process of giving promotions can go ahead however orders of promotions are not to be issued as the matter is pending.

12. MA for intervention is allowed in terms of prayer clause 9(a). Intervenors are to be added as party respondents in the above OA. Ld. Advocate for the applicants is directed to carry out the amendment and serve copy of amended OA on all the respondents.

13. Ld. Advocate for the Intervenors submits that considering the stage of the matter he does not wish to file any affidavit in reply. MA disposed off accordingly. OA adjourned to 2.5.2024.
