2. In the present O.A., the challenge is to the transfer order dated 04.07.2019 whereby the Applicant has been transferred from the post of LSDO, Panchayat Samiti, North Solapur to LSDO, Gr-1, Veterinary Dispensary, Talmod, Tal. Umarga, Dist. Osmanabad. The Applicant has assailed the transfer order on the ground though it is mid-term transfer, the same is not in consonance with Section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Transfer Act 2005').
3. Though the Applicant has completed his normal tenure, the transfer order being issued on 04.07.2019, it is assailed as mid-term transfer. In other connected matters wherein the same order is under challenge, the Tribunal has granted interim relief having found that there is no approval to the mid-term transfer by the next highest competent authority i.e. Hon'ble Chief Minister. It has been further noted that earlier the powers of general transfers were delegated to the Secretary but it was withdrawn and the Hon'ble Minister took over the powers. In that event also, there has to be approval of preceding Competent Authority, as per Table attached to Section 6 of 'Transfer Act 2005'.

The Applicant has challenged the impugned order on the ground that it is mid-term and mid-tenure transfer but not in consonance with Section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Act 2005) and therefore, prayed for interim relief.</p> <p>3. The Applicant has admittedly not completed three years tenure and was not due for transfer. Besides the transfer, the order is issued on 03.07.2019 and this being the position, there is no denying that it is mid-term as well as mid-tenure transfer.</p> <p>4. Learned P.O. has produced the file for the perusal which shows that the Applicant's matter was not at all placed before the Civil Services Board (CSB). The matter was placed before the CSB in respect of other employees. However, the Hon'ble Minister made a note that the Applicant be transferred at Aurangabad on vacant post and the same has been approved by the Hon'ble Chief Minister. While making note, the Hon'ble Minister, except stating 'administrative exigency' nothing is mentioned as to what constitute administrative exigency.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(P.T.O.)</i></p>


