Advocate submits that after his retirement the respondents not paid provisional pension from 1.10.2020 onwards. He is also not paid gratuity, GIS and leave encashment. Similarly his pension is also not fixed and paid. Respondent no.3 has also written letter on 7.6.2021 which is also challenged. By this letter respondent no.3 has directed respondent no.4 to recover difference amount of one year from the applicant.
