Special Court from the offences framed against him under the Prevention of Corruption Act. It further reveals that the State has preferred appeal against the said decision before the Hon'ble High Court and the same is pending. Documents on record further reveal that after the applicant was acquitted by the Special Court, the decision was taken by the Sub Divisional Officer - respondent no.2 to drop the enquiry being conducted against the applicant. It was further directed to regularize the period of suspension undergone by the applicant. The documents on record reveal that the aforesaid decision was taken on 28-09-2022. Thereafter, on 20-02-2023 respondent no.2 has passed another order thereby cancelling the earlier order dated 28-09-2022 relying on the G.R. dated 30-08-2018.

4. It is stated that the applicant is in the zone of consideration for promotion on the post of Circle Officer, however, he has not been considered for the said promotion because of pending criminal case and departmental enquiry against him. Learned Counsel for the applicant submitted that respondent no.2 was not having any right or authority to cancel the decision whereby the

departmental enquiry against the applicant was dropped and the period of his suspension was regularized. It has been further argued that, even otherwise on the said ground the applicant cannot be kept out of consideration for promotion to the post of Circle Officer. Learned Counsel submits that the process is now at the final stage and if interim orders are not passed the applicant may not be considered for his promotion to the said post. The applicant has, therefore, prayed for interim relief seeking directions against the respondents to open the sealed cover and to take decision in respect of granting promotion to the applicant.

5. Learned P.O. has opposed for granting any such interim relief stating that till final decision of the criminal appeal pending against the applicant, the applicant may not be considered for his promotion and the sealed cover cannot be opened.

6. Considered the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties. It is undisputed that the applicant is being not considered for his further promotion to the post of Circle Officer on the sole ground that the criminal appeal filed by the State against the order of his acquittal from the Special

Case is pending before the Hon'ble High Court. It is well settled that merely on the ground that criminal appeal is pending, the applicant cannot be denied the opportunity of acquiring further promotions, subject to the outcome of the criminal appeal pending against the applicant.

2. The applicants have filed the present Original Application seeking regularization of their services and for grant of benefits of permanency including permanent pay scale, allowances, continuity in service Government Resolution dated etc. 07.04.2022 issued by Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Department of the State Government is also sought to be quashed, whereby the staffing pattern has been revised and some posts are intended to be filled in through outsourcing.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the applicants submits that the applicants are working since last

many years, some have worked for more than 20 years and minimum service rendered by the applicants is 3 years. Learned counsel submits that similarly situated candidates had preferred O.A. No. 481/2023 before the Principal Seat of this Tribunal at Mumbai. Learned counsel pointed out that in the said matter this Tribunal has protected the interest of the applicants therein. Learned counsel submits that the present applicants stand at par with the applicants in the said O.A. and hence, deserves to be granted same interim relief.

4. Learned Presenting Officer has sought time to take instructions in the matter and to file affidavit in reply on behalf of the respondents. Learned P.O. however, has opposed for grant of any interim relief stating that unless the entire facts come on record, *prima facie*, it would be unjust to given any interim directions to the respondents in the present matter.

5. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicants and the respondent authorities. I have also gone through the documents filed on record. *Prima facie*, it appears that the

applicants' have identical case and identical relief is sought, which has been sought by the similarly situated candidates, who have filed O.A. No. 481/2023 before the Principal Seat of this Tribunal at Mumbai. Principal seat of this Tribunal at Mumbai has passed the following interim order in the said O.A.: -

"The balance of convenience lies in favor of the applicants No. 2, 4, 5, 7 & 8 and therefore, the services of the applicants are protected in the quota of 5457 posts which are going to be filled up by outsourcing."

6. Having regard to the fact that the present applicants stand at par with the applicants in the said matter, I deem it appropriate to take the same view as has been taken by the Principal Seat of this Tribunal at Mumbai and hence I am inclined to pass the following order: -

Shri Vinay B. Anjanwatikar, learned counsel appeared and has submitted that he is appearing on behalf of respondent No. 5. He has filed Caveat on behalf of the said respondent.

2. The present applicant had applied for the post of Police Patil for village Sonkhedi Tq. Amalner, District Jalgaon. He secured 43 marks in the written test. IN the merit list published by the respondents he stood at first position, whereas respondent No. 5 was at Sr. No. 2 and respondent No. 6 at Sr. No. 3. It is the case of the applicant that he submitted resignation of Member of the Gram Panchayat Sonkhedi on 17.8.2023. It is the further contention of the applicant that on 22.8.2023 he submitted an affidavit and the same is produced before the authorities at the time of verification of the documents. Objection was raised for consideration of the present applicant for the post of Police Patil by

respondent Nos. 5 & 6. It was their contention that the applicant contravenes the condition as imposed in the advertisement and more particularly condition No. 6 of the said advertisement, which reads thus: -

"६. अर्जदारांचे कोणत्याही राजकीय पक्षाशी संबंध नसावा. त्याचप्रमाणे तो इतर ठिकाणी संपूर्ण वेळ नोकरी करणारा व ग्रामपंचायत सदस्य नसावा. तसेच खाजगी किंवा निमसरकारी संस्थेचा सदस्य नसावा, अथवा पूर्णवेळ नोकरी करणारा नसावा याबाबतचे रुपये १००/- च्या स्टॅम्प पेपरवरील प्रतिज्ञापत्र हे कागद पडताळणीच्या वेळी सादर करणे आवश्यक राहील."

3. The Chairman of the Recruitment Committee i.e. the Sub Divisional Officer of Amalner accepted the objection raised on behalf of respondent Nos. 5 & 6 and vide order passed on 31.8.2023 declared the applicant to be not eligible for the post of Police Patil and he was restricted from participating in the further selection process. The said order has been challenged by the applicant by filing the present Original Application.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No. 14191/2017 relying on which the learned S.D.O. has passed the impugned order has been set aside by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Civil Appeal No. 2712/2019 (arising from SLP (C) No. 21256/2018). Learned counsel invited my attention to the discussion made in paragraph Nos. 13 & 14 of the said judgment and in view of the

order so passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court submitted that the impugned order in terms of the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court apparently cannot be sustained. Learned counsel in the circumstances while issuing notice to the respondents prayed for interim direction thereby restraining the respondents from carrying out the further process of the appointment of Police Patil for the village Sonkhedi, Tq. Amalner, Dist. Jalgaon, till decision of the present Original Application.

5. The request so made has been strongly opposed by the learned P.O., as well as, learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 5. Learned counsel for respondent No. 5 reading out the terms and conditions incorporated in the advertisement submitted that the applicant has apparently violated the terms and conditions as are incorporated in the advertisement concerned. Learned counsel further submitted that on the date of verification of the documents, resignation of the applicant was not accepted and thus on the date of verification also he was Member of Grampanchayat of Sonkhedi, Tq. Amalner. Learned counsel submitted that in such circumstances the applicant has not made out any case for causing interference in the impugned order or for grant of any interim relief as prayed for by the applicant. Learned P.O. also opposed for grant of any interim relief stating

that the applicant was supposed to resign from the post of Member of Grampanchayat much before the date he actually resigned and he must have ensured that his resignation is accepted before he applied for the post of Police Patil.

6. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and the respondent authorities. I have also gone through the judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Division Bench of the High Court in W.P. NO. 14191/2017, as well as, the judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Civil Appeal No. 2712/2019 (arising from SLP (C) No. 21256/2018). From the documents and more particularly on perusal of the decision rendered by the Hon'ble Apex Court it is revealed that the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No. 14191/2017 relying on which the learned S.D.O. has passed the impugned order was set aside by the Hon'ble Apex Court. Perhaps this fact was not brought to the notice of the S.D.O. As has been observed by the Hon'ble Apex Court an office bearer or Member of Local Body, who is candidate for a post of Police Patil may be considered for such post but he could be appointed Police Patil only on his actual resignation.

7. As has come on record, the resignation of the applicant was accepted on 25.8.2023. The applicant has however, in his affidavit submitted at the time of verification of his documents i.e. on 22.8.2023 specifically stated that he has resigned from the post of Member of Gram Panchayat by submitting his resignation letter on 17.8.2023 and that he has not participated thereafter in any meeting of the Gram Panchayat or has not participated in the affairs of the Gram Panchayat. In the aforesaid circumstances in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court the applicant cannot be kept out of consideration for his appointment for the post of Police Patil. I am, therefore, inclined to pass the following order: -

ORDER

(i) Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 14.9.2023, till then the respondents shall not proceed with the process of appointment for the post of Police Patil of village Sonkhedi, Tq. Amalner, District Jalgaon.

(ii) Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

(iii) Applicants are authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

Heard Shri Prasad Kadam, learned counsel for the applicant and Shri B.S. Deokar, learned Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities.

2. Applicant is aspiring for his selection for the post of Kotwal for which respondent nos. 2 & 3 had published the advertisement on 27.7.2023. The said post was to be filled in by direct recruitment. The applicant has been held not eligible for appearing in the written examination to be held as a part of the process of the said recruitment on the ground that the applicant is overage. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the reason, which has assigned is unsustainable. Learned counsel submits that the applicant belongs to Scheduled Caste category for which the upper age limit prescribed is 42 years. Learned counsel further submits that some age relaxation was also granted on the ground of non-recruitment for the said post during the period of CORONA pandemic. Learned

counsel submits that the applicant must have been held eligible to appear for the said examination. Learned counsel invited my attention to the advertisement published by Taluka Selection Committee, Umarga on 16.6.2023 for the post of Kotwal, wherein the upper age limit for reserved caste category candidates is prescribed as 42 years.

3. After having gone through the averments raised in the present O.A. and after having perused the G.R. dated 3.3.2023 and the advertisement published by the Taluka Selection Committee, Umarge there appears prima-facie case in favour of the applicant.

4. Learned Presenting Officer was called upon to explain why in two different advertisements one published by the Sub Divisional Officer, Pathri and other published by the Taluka Selection Committee, Umarga different upper age limits are prescribed. There is no explanation submitted on behalf of the State in this regard.

5. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that written examination is to be held on 10.09.2023 for which hall tickets will be issued tomorrow.

6. In view of the fact that prima-facie case is made out by the applicant, if he is not permitted to appear for the examination, the present application would become infructuous. I, therefore, deem it appropriate to pass the following order :-

<u>O R D E R</u>

1. Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 29.09.2023.

2. Respondent nos. 3 & 4 are directed to issue hall ticket to the present applicant and allow him to appear in the written examination to be held on 10.09.2023, subject to outcome of the present O.A.

3. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

4. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

5. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
