  - (3) possess a Certificate in Computer Operation prescribed by the Directorate of Information and Technology, Government of Maharashtra, from time to time. Provided that preference will be given to a Masters Degree in Law of a statutory University or any other qualification declared by Government to be equivalent thereto."

(Quoted from page 22-23 of OA)

4. Rule 3(b) Of Desk Officer in the Mantralaya Department (Recruitment) Rules, 1981 reads as follows:

- 6. They are different channels with different educational qualification and duties. In any case the proper forum to redress their grievance would be the Pay Anomalies Committee of the Government on the ground that theirs is a totally different channel of recruitment.
- 7. Ld. Advocate for the applicants, on instructions from the applicants, seeks leave to withdraw the above OA with liberty to approach the proper forum i.e. Pay Anomalies Committee of the Government.
- 8. Leave granted. OA is allowed to be withdrawn and disposed off as such with above liberty.

- 1. Heard Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicants and Smt. Archana B. K. holding for Shri A. J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. This M.A. is filed for condonation of delay of four months or in alternate condonation of delay of 2 ½ years caused in filing O.A.No.949/2021 challenging the order dated 19.06.2018 whereby recovery ofRs.5,20,656/- has been imposed from monthly salary of the Applicant starting from July, 2018.
