This M.A. is filed for condonation of delay of four months or in alternate condonation of delay of 2 ½ years caused in filing O.A.No.949/2021 challenging the order dated 19.06.2018 whereby recovery ofRs.5,20,656/- has been imposed from monthly salary of the Applicant starting from July, 2018.</p> <p>3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant pointed out that the Applicant has worked on promotional post from 01.04.2000 to 31.05.2018 and thereafter he was reverted on the ground that he did not submit Caste Validity Certificate in terms of roster. He submits that since the Applicant has already worked on promotional post, the question of recovery of salary on promotional post is totally bad in law. As regard delay, he submits that in view of Covid-19 pandemic situation and the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court extending the period of limitation, the delay comes to four months. He, therefore, prayed for interim relief.</p> <p>4. 
