The copies of the application submitted by the Applicant on 05.04.2022 to 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' were endorsed to 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' and 'Superintendent of Police Beed'. The 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 30.11.2023 also mentions that the 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' by letter dated 26.08.2022 had forwarded the application of the Applicant dated 05.04.2022 along with other applications of 'Senior Grade Clerk' and 'Junior Grade Clerk' and it was received only on 02.09.2022 in the office of 'Special IGP, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar Range'. The 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 30.11.2023 also affirms that the procedure for promotion of 'Junior Grade Clerk' to posts of 'Senior Grade Clerk' had already commenced on 13.06.2022 and therefore the office of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' was informed that it would not be possible to submit N.O.C. in respect of the Applicant.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits the copy of order dated 19.10.2023 issued by 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' which shows that large number of 'Senior Grade Clerks' were promoted to the posts of</p>

The reasons stated in the 'Affidavit-in-Reply' on behalf of the 'Special IGP, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar Range' for not granting NOC for the Applicant, are belated receipt on 02.09.2022 of the application submitted by Applicant on 05.04.2022 to 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' and because procedure had already started on 13.06.2022 for promotion of eligible 'Junior Grade Clerks' to posts of 'Senior Grade Clerks'.</p> <p>5. The reasons are not justiciable as 12 posts of 'Senior Grade Clerks' in the jurisdiction of 'Special IGP Office, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar Range' came to be filled much later by promotion order dated 17.03.2023. Thereafter, from the order dated 19.10.2023 issued by 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' it is evident that more than 10 posts of 'Senior Clerk' have now become available after promotion of incumbents to post of 'Head Clerk' in the jurisdiction of 'Special IGP, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar Range'. Hence taking into account all the facts &amp; circumstances as stated above and notably that Applicant had submitted her Application on 05.04.2022 to 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' it came to be forwarded belatedly by 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' on 26.08.2022, in the interest of justice it is directed that 'Special IGP, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar Range' should issue N.O.C. within 'One Week' for acceptance of Applicant on available post of 'Senior Grade Clerk' and forward it to the office of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' and 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'.
