ORAL ORDER:

Heard Shri C.V.Dharurkar, learned Counsel for the applicant and Shri M.S.Mahajan, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities.

Applicant has filed the present O.A. aggrieved 2. the order dated 22-06-2023 whereby the applicant has been transferred from Railway Police Station, Nandurbar to Railway Police Station, Manmad. It is the grievance of the applicant that he has not completed his ordinary tenure at Nandurbar and in the circumstances was not liable to be transferred from the said station. Learned Counsel for the applicant has relied upon the provisions under the Maharashtra Police Act, more particularly, the provisions under Section 22-N. Learned Counsel further submitted that the applicant has not yet handed over the charge of his existing post and no one has been yet posted in place of the applicant. In the circumstances, the applicant has prayed for interim relief thereby

staying the effect and operation of the impugned order till decision of the present O.A.

- 3. Learned CPO has opposed the submissions made and the interim relief sought by the applicant. Learned CPO submitted that the applicant was attached to Bhusawal Railway Police and for convenience and on his own request he was then attached to Nandurbar Police Station coming under the Bhusawal Railway Police. Learned CPO submitted that the applicant has completed the entire ordinary period and as such there is no substance in the contentions raised by the applicant that he is being transferred before completing his ordinary tenure at Nandurbar. Learned CPO further submitted that the applicant has not been relieved for the reason that he is on sick leave and the moment he resumes duty, he will be relieved. Learned CPO in the circumstances opposed for grant of interim relief as prayed for by the applicant.
- 4. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and the respondents. It is not in dispute that vide order dated 17-10-2020 the applicant was posted at Control Room Railways at

Aurangabad. From Aurangabad on his request, the applicant came to be posted at Nandurbar vide order dated 15-04-2021. Learned Counsel has invited my attention to the Government Resolution dated 23-04-2010. Clause 8 thereof reads thus:

"क.(८) ''तात्पुरते संलग्न करणे'' ही कार्यवाही देखील बदली अधिनियमानुसार बदलीच आहे. बदली अधिनियमामध्ये तात्पुरते संलग्न करणे अशी तरतुद नसल्याने कोणताही अधिकारी/कर्मचारी यांना तात्पुरते संलग्न करण्याचे आदेश काढून बदली करण्यात येवू नये. काही विशेष कारणामुळे या अधिकारी/कर्मचारी यांची तात्काळ बदली करणे आवश्यक असल्यास बदली अधिनियमातील तरतुदीनुसार असे प्रस्ताव लगत नंतरच्या विरिष्ठ प्राधिका-याच्या मान्यतेसाठी सादर करण्यात यावे."

- 5. As per the clarification given above, the order dated 15-04-2021 whereby the applicant was posted at Nandurbar must be held to be transferred to the said post though the words are used that, 'he is attached' to the said Police Station. It is thus evident that the applicant has completed the period of hardly two years at Nandurbar.
- 6. Considering the facts as aforesaid, it appears that the applicant has made out a prima facie case.

In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to pass the following order:

ORDER

- 7. Issue notice to the respondents returnable on 14-07-2023. Till then the respondents shall not relieve the applicant from his existing post.
- 8. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- 9. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

- 2. The applicant has filed the present Original Application seeking the following relief: -
 - "B) To quash and set aside the impugned suspension order dated 13.03.2023 issued by the respondent No.2 placing the applicant under suspension from the post of City Survey Officer, Aurangabad, District Aurangabad."

The applicant has also sought the following interim relief

"(a) Pending hearing and final disposal of this original application, the impugned suspension order dated 13.03.2023 issued by the respondent No.2 placing the applicant under suspension from the post of City Survey Officer, Aurangabad, District Aurangabad may kindly be stayed and the applicant may be continue on the same post in forthwith, in view

of this Government Resolution dated 09.07.2019 as the suspension came to end after 90 days."

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant had earlier filed O.A. No. 236/2023 seeking quashment of the order of suspension passed against her. The said application was however, disposed of by this Tribunal on 18.4.2023 by giving liberty to the applicant to file appeal against the said order and the respondents were directed to decide the said appeal preferably within the period of 8 weeks' from the date of submitting appeal by the applicant. Learned counsel submitted that the respondents did not decide the appeal within the given period. Learned counsel further submitted that the respondents have not reviewed the order of suspension though the period of more than 90 days' has expired from the date on which the order of suspension was passed. Learned counsel, relying on the judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs. Union of India Through its Secretary & Anr., (2015) 7 SCC 291 and the Government Resolution dated 9th July, 2019 issued on the basis of the said judgment, has prayed for quashment of

the order of suspension and in the alternative to pass an order thereby directing the respondents to reinstate the applicant.

- 4. Shri N.U. Yadav, learned Presenting Officer submitted that according to the instructions received to the office of Chief Presenting Officer, the chargesheet will be served on the applicant within 8 days' from today and the review would also be taken by the competent authority of the order of suspension passed against the applicant within the same period i.e. 8 days'. Learned Presenting Officer submitted that there were compelling circumstances because of which it may not become possible for the respondents to prepare and get approved the chargesheet to be served upon the applicant. Presenting Officer submitted that considering the serious charges against the applicant the respondents be given time of 10 days' to serve charge-sheet on the applicant and to take review of the order of suspension passed against her.
- 5. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, as well as, the respondents.

6. The applicant has been suspended vide order passed on 13th March, 2023. As has been mandated by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs. Union of India Through its Secretary & Anr., (cited supra), the respondents must serve the statement of charge upon the applicant within 90 days from the date of his or her suspension. Hon'ble Apex Court has further mandated that the review of the order of suspension has also to be taken within the period of 90 days' and thereafter periodically if the suspension is to be continued by recording reasons therefor. Based on the said judgment the Maharashtra Government has issued a Government Resolution dated 9th July, 2019, it reads thus, ""

- 9. या अनुषंगाने शासकीय कर्मचाऱ्याच्या निलंबनाचा आढावा घेण्यासंदर्भात पुढीलप्रमाणे सूचना देण्यात येत आहेत.
- i) निलंबित शासकीय सेवकांच्या ज्या प्रकरणी ३ महिन्यांच्या कालावधीत विभागीय चौकशी सुरू करून देषारोप पत्र बजावण्यात आले आहे, अशा प्रकरणी निलंबन केल्यापासून ३ महिन्यात निलंबनाचा आढावा घेऊन निलंबन पुढे चालू ठेवावयाचे असलयास त्याबाबतचा निर्णय सुरपष्ट आदेशासह (कारण मिमांसेसह) सक्षम प्राधिकान्याच्या स्तरावर घेण्यात यावा.

- iii) फोजदारी प्रकरणात विशेषतः लाचलुचपत प्रकरणी निलंबित शासकीय सेवकांवर विभागीय चौकशी सुरू करून दोषारोप पत्र बजावणेबाबत आवश्यक तो अभिलेख लाचलुचपत प्रतिबंधक विभागाने संबंधीत प्रशासकीय विभागास उपलब्ध करून देणे आवश्यक राहिल.

या आदेशातील तरतुर्दीमुळे या विषयावरील संदर्भ १ व २ येथील आदेशांतील तरतुर्दी या आदेशाच्या मर्यादेत सुधारण्यात आल्या आहेत असे समजण्यात यावे.

- ३. सदर शासन निर्णय महाराष्ट्र शासनाच्या <u>www.maharashtra.gov.in</u> या वेबसाईटवर उपलबध करण्यात आला असून त्याचा संगणक संकेतांक २०१९०७०९१५२०४०५२०७ असा आहे. हा आदेश डिजीटल स्वाक्षरीने साक्षांकित करून काढयात येत आहे."
- 7. It is not in dispute that 90 days' are over after passing of the order of suspension. It is further not in dispute that till today the statement of charge is not served upon the applicant nor review has been taken by the reviewing authority of the said order of

suspension. In the circumstances, though now the respondents have come out with a prayer that within 8 days' the charge sheet would also be served upon the applicant and review would also be taken and hence, have prayed for such extension, in view of the mandate given by the Hon'ble Apex Court and having regard to the Government Resolution dated 9th July, 2019, it may not be possible to concede the request of the respondents. In view of the facts mentioned as aforesaid the applicant has certainly made out a *prima facie* case and her suspension cannot be permitted to be continued henceforth.

8. As has been clarified by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the judgment of Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs. Union of India Through its Secretary & Anr. (cited supra), the Government is free to transfer the applicant to any department in any of its office or on any suitable place whether she can be transferred, so that there may not be any possibility of misuse of her post by the applicant in influencing witness or manipulating evidence which is likely to come in the enquiry. However, in no case the respondents can be permitted to keep the applicant under suspension henceforth. Hence, the following interim order is passed:-

Application seeking leave to incorporate the subsequent facts and bring them on record and also to make the additional prayer in that regard.
- 3. The learned counsel for the applicant further submitted that the applicant is willing to join at his transferred place. However, in view of the orders

passed by this Tribunal, which have attained the finality, the applicant cannot be treated as the Officer falling in Group-B category. 4. The learned C.P.O. fairly conceded for partly allowing the present Misc. Application to the extent of amendment. The learned C.P.O., however, has opposed for granting any interim order as submitted by the applicant and submits that within 2 weeks respondents will file the affidavit in reply.

5. The amendment sought is in consonance with the prayers made in the O.A. and based on the subsequent events, I am, therefore, inclined to allow the present Misc. Application. In the the present matter are circumstances, the applicant has made out a primafacie case to consider his case to grant similar relief in his favour. Hence, the following order:-
