

The issue involved in all these O.As. is pertaining to non relieving of 187 Police Sub-Inspector transferred on the their request from the establishment of the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai to other parts of the State of Maharashtra.</li> <li>3. As per the Affidavit filed by the Director General of Police, minutes of P.E.B.-2 was sent for approval by circulation to prominent Members of P.E.B.-2. but the <u>Commissioner of Police, Mumbai and Secretary, Home Department (Appeal and Security)</u> did not sign it.</li> <li>4. It is seen from the Affidavit filed by the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai that he had certain reservation about the transfer of 187 Police Personnel without providing substitute, and therefore he did not sign it. He also raised grievances by sending letter dated 30.12.2021 to Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department on the issue. Thus <i>prima-facie</i> there is no meaningful consultation or deliberation among the Members of P.E.B. It appears that first decision was recorded and sent to the Members for signature by way of circulation, and thereafter only certain information was called from the Commissioner of Police in respect of the Transfers. Indeed, all such information ought to have been called for before any such decision and after considering the same only, appropriate decision by recording specific reason to that effect ought to have been taken by P.E.B.-2.</li> </ol> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>[P.T.O.]</i></p> |

Hence the authority has cancelled the validity certificate of the Applicant Ms. Naik. 

5. Learned P.O. submits that cost is deposited in the Tribunal and steps are already taken to release retiral benefits of the Applicant and papers are submitted to Treasury Office.

6. Learned P.O. prayed to recall order of imposing cost of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand Only) *inter-alia* contending that the Applicant was transferred on the establishment of Collector, Raigad before about 6 months of his retirement. According to her, Collector, Raigad has written several letters to the concerned Department where the Applicant was initially posted and tried to get service book updated. Para 4 of M.A. reveals that some correspondence was made but except 30.10.2015 all other correspondence are post retirement, which clearly shows that no such steps were taken well in advance of retirement. Indeed, as per Rule 120 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, steps for completion of service book is required to be initiated 2 years before retirement of Government servant. However, no such steps were taken and the Applicant is deprived of retiral benefits for more than 6 years. It is for this reason noticing sheer negligence on the part of concerned the Tribunal has imposed costs of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand Only) while granting extension of time. As such cost has been rightly imposed.

7. In view of above, M.A. for recalling order of cost is without any merit and liable to be dismissed. Collector, Raigad is at liberty to recover cost of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand Only) from the concerned official who are responsible for the same.

8. Cost deposited in Tribunal be paid to the Applicant on his Application.

9. M.A. is accordingly dismissed with no order as to costs.


