- 2. The applicant had challenged the selection of Respondent no. 7 and his appointment order dated 6.12.2014 and he claims that he is be appointed as Technician by removing Respondent no. 7.
- The Respondent no. 4, Deputy Director of Health Services, has issued the advertisement dated 22.8.2013, inviting applications for 25 posts of Technician, HEMR. The applicant had applied on 26.8.2013 for the post from open category as no post was available for S.C category. The select list was published on 20.12.2013 and in the merit list the name of the applicant appeared at serial no. 10 and he was entitled for selection from open category, because 12 posts of open category was available for selection. One post for Ex-servicemen category was complied with by appointing Ex-servicemen, so also four posts for Women were complied. Some part time employees were given benefit of Horizontal reservation and therefore the claim of present applicant was ignored and Respondents no 7 who was at serial no. 12 in the merit list, that is below the applicant, who is at serial no. 10. The applicant relies on the G.R dated 16.3.1999. He was informed that Respondent no. 7 was selected from Horizontal reservation giving benefit of Sports category, though Respondent no. 7 was not eligible as he was not having Certificate of Sports and Respondent no. 7 has never claimed the post from Sports category. However, applicant was informed that selection of Respondent no. 7 was made as per recommendation of Respondent no. 5, that is Managing Director & CEO, MKCL, as no Sports candidate was available
- 4. Learned counsel Mr Bandiwadekar for Respondent no. 7 submits that in the sur-rejoinder, Respondent no. 7 has pointed out that in fact the applicant was not holding the necessary educational qualification and also the necessary experience as advertised.
- 5. Learned P.O to take instructions in the matter.
