Heard Dr. G. Sadavarte, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Mr. N.K. Rajpurohit, the learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

The Applicant is a Lecturer in Respondent No.3 – Director, Veermata Jijabai Technological Institute. She came to be appointed on ad-hoc basis for a period of 11 months by an order dated 2.6.2016 w.e.f.1.7.2016. I am told that, that was the last order which is valid till today. Interim relief is sought in the form of maintenance of status quo. There is apparently dispute which is being raised by the Respondents with regard to the jurisdiction. The facts are such that, as of today, I do not think, any interim relief can be granted. But even then, a few points must be noted quite clearly.

In the first place, on the date appointed for filing of the reply, the Affidavi-in-reply must be filed clearly spelling out the nature of the dispute about the jurisdiction. Secondly, even if the order above referred to, expires today but the Tribunal just like any other judicial forum is sufficiently empowered to make orders of mandatory nature even at interlocutory stage, and therefore, nothing would turn on any technicality in that respect. All other aspects of the matter are left open,

Issue notice made returnable on 14.06.2017.

Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal need not be issued.

Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988 and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
