- For the aforesaid reasons, O.A.s are disposed of with direction to Respondents to issue posting order within a week from the data sylender.

The Applicant has challenged order issued by the Government dated 25.05.2021 as well as order dated 27.05.2021 issued by Respondent No.2 The Deputy Director of Education, Pune which has been on the basis of main order dated 25.05.2021. Thus order dated 27.05.2021 is in compliance of order issued by the Government dated 25.05.2021, and therefore, main challenge is to the order dated 25.05.2021 issued by the Respondent No.1 Government of Maharashtra.
- 3. Shri M.D. Lonkar, learned Advocate for the Applicant prayed for interim relief to stay orders dated 25.05.2021 as well as 27.05.2021 contending that the Applicant's repatriation and posting in Municipal Council, Aalandi is illegal since, the Applicant has been absorbed and posted in Group 'C' in School and Education Department on the basis of orders passed by the Government as well as order dated 10.03.2021 issued by Commissioner of Education, Pune.
- 4. Whereas, Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned P.O. pressed the issue of jurisdiction contending that basic challenge is to legality of the appointment of the Applicant on the establishment of School and Education Department by virtue of order dated 10.03.2016. She has pointed out that order dated 10.03.2016 has been cancelled and recalled by the Government by order

dated 25.05.2021 and this being the position, basic issue involved pertains to the appointment. She has therefore submitted that matter should be placed before the Division Bench.

- 5. Admittedly the Applicant initially was appointed as Special Educator in the establishment of Municipal Council, Aalandi. However, later the Commissioner Education, Pune by his order dated 10.03.2016, approved the proposal for giving posting to the Applicant in Group 'C' cadre in School and Education Department and he was accordingly appointed as Administrative Officer. However, later it was revealed to the Government that appointment of the Applicant by order dated 10.03.2021 issued by the Commissioner Education was not in accordance to law and his appointment was contrary to the Rules. Therefore Government by order dated 25.05.2021 recalled the order of Commissioner Education, Pune dated 10.03.2021 and transferred the service of the Applicant to his Original Department in Municipal Council.
- 6. Thus, it is not the case of simply repatriation but basic issue pertains to the appointment by order dated 10.03.2016, which has been recalled and cancelled by Government having found that the appointment was not in accordance to law.
- 7. Thus being the position obviously issue pertains to the appointment and its cancellation which subject pertains to the Division Bench.
- 8. Registrar is therefore directed to examine the matter and place before the appropriate Bench.
- 9. At this stage, learned Advocate submits that he has no objection if matter is placed at Division Bench.
- 10. Since the interim relief is asked for, Registrar is directed to list the matter on 03.06.2021.

- 3. On perusal of record as well as on hearing of learned Counsel as well learned P.O., it transpires that D.E. was initiated against the Applicant by issuance of charge sheet dated 20.04.2015, however, no further steps were taken to complete the D.E. and ultimately the Applicant stands retired on 30.09.2018.
- 4. Indeed, in view of various G.R.s as well as Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979, the D.E. initiated against the Government servant is required to be completed within six months.

Office Notes, Office Memoranda of Coram, Appearance, Tribunal's orders or directions and Registrar's orders

Tribunal's orders

- In this behalf, reference may be made to Circular dated 07.04.2008 whereby the directions were issued to complete the D.E. within six months. However, in the present case though the D.E. was initiated in 2015, it is still incomplete due to sheer laxity and negligence on the part of the Respondents. The Applicant is deprived of retiral benefits due to pendency of D.E. which ought to have been completed within six months from the date of issuance of charge sheet.
- Suffice to day, negligence and carelessness on the part of Respondents to follow the instructions as well as rules is writ at large.
- In view of above observations, I am inclined to dispose of O.A. with directions to Respondents to complete the D.E. including passing final order therein within three months from today without fail.
- 8. The Respondents are directed to complete the D.E. pending against the Applicant within three months from today including final order thereon in accordance to law and the decision as the case may be, shall be communicated to the Applicant within two weeks thereafter.
- 9. After decision of D.E. further steps for release of gratuity and leave encashment be issued subject to order in D.E..
- 10. The Applicant is at liberty to avail legal remedy for grant of interest in accordance to law, if any.
- 11. No order as to costs.
