Hence, Medical officers who do not attain the age of 60 years during the period from 01.06.2022 to 31.05.2023 shall be deemed to retire on the last date of the month in which the Medical Officer attains the age of 60 years. E.g. Medical Officers who will complete 58 years of age on 24.04.2023 will retire on 30.04.2025 instead of retiring on 31.05.2023 as per the above provision. Also Medical Officers who will complete 58 years of age on 24.06.2023 will however retire on 30.06.2023 as per original provision of Rule 10 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension), Rules, 1982"
