- 4. Learned Presenting Officer has submitted that the facts mentioned in the above cited decisions referred by the learned Advocate for the applicant are not identical with the facts in the present case and therefore, the said decisions are not applicable in the present case. He has submitted that the applicant has challenged the suspension order before the appellate authority by preferring an appeal and representations in view of the provisions of Section 20 of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 and therefore, the present O.A. cannot be entertained.
- 5. On perusal of the record, it reveals that the impugned order has been passed on 28/29.07.2020. applicant has filed representations 29.07.2020, 01.08.2020 and 11.08.2020 before the higher authority challenging the impugned order. Not only this, but he has challenged the suspension order by preferring an appeal on 03.08.2020 before the

appellate authority as provided in the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1979. The representations and appeal filed by the applicant is still pending and same are not yet decided by the concerned authorities. The applicant has availed the remedy available to him under service rules by preferring the appeal and therefore, the present O.A. cannot be admitted before expiry of stipulated time mentioned in Section 20 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. Hence, the O.A. cannot be admitted. Consequently, the O.A. deserves to be rejected.

6. In view of the above, the O.A. stands rejected. There shall be no order as to costs.
