 - B) This Hon'ble Court may pleased to direct the respondents to give promotion to the applicant on the post of Daftar Karkoon since the deemed date 21.02.1981 of the applicant experience, along with ancillary benefit i.e. salary enhancement and all other benefits for which the applicant is entitled for.
 - C) In the alternate, pending hearing and final disposal of this Original Application direct the respondents to promote the applicant on the post of Dafter Karkoon.

- D) Any other suitable and equitable relief may kindly be granted in favour of the applicant."
- 3. It is not in dispute that the applicant was working as Canal Inspector. The Recruitment Rules of 1962 provide that for promotion to the post of Daptar Karkoon, the feeder cadre is Section Karkoon and Muster Karkoon. In the circumstances, as has been rightly contended by the respondent no. 2 in the affidavit in reply, the applicant was not entitled for claiming such promotion. We, therefore, see no case in favour of the applicant.
- 4. Learned counsel submitted that during the pendency of the present Original Application the of applicant retired on attaining the age superannuation on 31.8.2013. Learned counsel further submitted that at the appropriate time a favourable proposal was forwarded to the Government, however, it is not considered. Learned counsel submits that the applicant is now praying for the only relief to direct the respondents to decide that proposal and is not claiming any other relief in
