 - "A) By issuing appropriate order or direction in the like nature, the Respondent Authorities may kindly be directed to grant the promotion to the present applicant in the class III cadre with all service benefit, in view of the order passed by Respondent No. 2 dated 23.9.2013."
- 3. The affidavit in reply is filed on behalf of res. no. 3 by Shri Shankar Govindrao Pusnake, Dist. Dairy Development Officer, Beed along with copy of statement made by the Commissioner of Dairy Development, Mumbai dated 30.9.2014. This statement is made before the competent authority / Commissioner of Handicapped Welfare, Mumbai, copy whereof is at page 36. In para 3 therein, the Commissioner of Dairy Development has made a statement that in case the present applicant would acquire requisite qualification of typing etc. then he would be given benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme and in case he acquires further qualification, then second benefit of A.C.P. scheme would also be made applicable to him.
