In Superintendent, Central the circumstances, learned counsel has sought interim relief seeking direction against the respondents to include name of the present applicant in the zone of consideration prepared for ensuing promotions to the cadre of Superintendent, Central Prison, Class-I.

- 4. Learned C.P.O. has sought time to take instructions in the present matter and has therefore, requested to consider the request even for interim relief thereafter.
- 5. I have gone through the documents filed on record. It prima-facie, appears that the applicant was not promoted at the relevant time, as the departmental proceedings were pending against him. Record shows that now he has been exonerated from the charges levelled in the Departmental Enquiry and has also been

promoted to the post of Superintendent, District Prison, Class-I. The applicant has got information that the D.P.C. is likely to be held for promotions in next few days. However, no concrete information is thereof on record. In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to pass the following order:-
