Applicant is intending to apply for the post of Professor in Pediatrics in pursuance of the Advertisement No.337/2023 issued by MPSC on 15-For appointment on the said post, the 12-2023. candidate concerned is required to have 3 years' experience as Associate Professor in the subject for which he has to apply of working in recognized Medical College/Institution. It is the case of the applicant that, he has been working as an Associate Professor in the Government Medical College at The Jalgaon from 20-09-2019. order of appointment dated 20-09-2019 is placed on record by the applicant. The aforesaid appointment was given to the applicant for the period of 360 days. Thereafter, the applicant was given appointment on

the second time also for the period of 360 days w.e.f. 15-09-2020 to 09-09-2021. On third time also similar appointment order was issued in favour of the applicant for the period of next 360 days i.e. from 14-09-2021 to 08-09-2022.

3. Learned Counsel for the applicant submitted that since the experience which has been stipulated in the advertisement is of the period of 3 years, the experience of the applicant fails short by 15 days. It is, however, the case of the applicant that though the last order issued in favour of the applicant was till 08-09-2022, even after expiry of the said period, the applicant continued to work without any break till 28-09-2022. Thereafter, on 28-09-2022 vide the order passed by the Dean, Government Medical College, Jalgaon, he has been reverted to the post of Assistant Professor.

4. Learned Counsel for the applicant further submitted that if the period between 09-09-2022 to 28-09-2022 is considered as the period of his service, the applicant fulfills the criteria of having work experience of 3 years as prescribed in the advertisement. Learned Counsel submitted

that such certificate was prayed for by the applicant by making a request application to the Dean of the Government Medical College, Jalgaon and the learned Dean has forwarded the proposal in that regard to Commissioner, Medical Education and Research. Mumbai. who is the appropriate seeking his guidance. authority. In the said proposal it is stated that the applicant had in fact worked for the period of 3 years, if the services rendered by the applicant during the period between 09-09-2022 to 28-09-2022 are taken into account. Learned Counsel further submitted that, however, the applicant did not receive any positive response from respondent no.2. Learned Counsel submitted that inspite of having worked for the period of 3 years, if the experience certificate is not issued by the respondents, he will be deprived from contesting for his selection on the post of Professor in pursuance of Advertisement No.337/2023.

5. On 03-01-2024 when the matter was heard for the first time by us, after having considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and

after having gone through the documents placed on record, we were prima facie convinced that the applicant has certainly rendered the services for the period of 3 years. In these circumstances, while issuing notice to the respondents in the present O.A., learned C.P.O. was instructed to take instructions the from concerned department whether the applicant has worked on the post of Assistant Professor till 28-09-2022 and whether he has been paid salary for the said period and to make statement in that regard on the next date, which was fixed on today. Today, when the matter is taken up for consideration, Shri M.P.Gude, learned P.O. appeared for the respondent authorities. has Learned P.O. submitted a written communication received from the Dean of the Government Medical College, Jalgaon wherein a request has been made for getting 4 weeks' time for submitting the affidavit in reply.

6. On our query made to the learned P.O. whether instructions are received as were directed to be taken from the concerned officer in the order passed by the Tribunal on 03-01-2024, Shri Gude,

learned P.O. submitted that the order passed on 03-01-2024 was duly communicated to the Government Medical College, Jalgaon as well as to all concerned. Learned P.O. further submitted that he also talked to Shri Mangesh Joshi, Office Superintendent of the Government Medical College, Jalgaon and also to Dr. Jitendra Ghumre, HOD, OBGY, who is also incharge of the Legal Cell. Learned P.O. further submitted that both the aforesaid officers, however, refused to provide any such information. The conduct of the aforesaid officers, prima facie, appears to be contemptuous. Learned P.O. on the basis of another communication received to him prayed for granting time of 4 weeks for filing the affidavit in reply.

7. Shri J.S.Deshmukh, learned Counsel submitted that for making application for the post of Professor, the last date is 09-01-2024. Learned Counsel in the circumstances invited our attention to the documents filed on record showing that the applicant has actually worked during the period between 09-09-2022 to 28-09-2022 and has also been paid salary of the said period. The order of

reversion is also referred to, from the contents of which it is discernible that, the applicant worked on the said post till he was reverted to the post of Assistant Professor on 28-09-2022.

8. We have carefully perused the documents placed on record by the parties. In so far as the services rendered by the applicant for consecutive 3 years, every time for the period of 360 days are concerned, the appointment orders are placed on record. The order of reversion passed on 28-09-2022 demonstrates that the applicant was rendering his services till the said date i.e. 28-09-2022 though his period of earlier appointment expired on 08-09-2022. The payment slip which is filed on record evinces that the applicant has been paid salary of the post of Assistant Professor for the entire month meaning thereby that the applicant is held to have worked on the said post in the entire said month.

9. After having gone through the documents placed on record it appears that sufficient prima facie evidence is existing on record showing that the

applicant had worked during the period between 09-09-2022 till 28-09-2022. If the said period is taken into account and added to the services earlier rendered by the applicant for the period of consecutive 3 terms of 360 days each, the applicant has to be held to have worked for the period of more than 3 years. The applicant is, thus, prima facie fulfilling the criteria of having experience of worked as Associate Professor for the period of 3 years in the Government Medical College at Jalgaon.

10. In the aforesaid circumstances, we see no difficulty in directing the respondent nos.2 and 4 to issue such certificate in favour of the applicant on or before 08-09-2023, so that, the applicant can apply for the post of Professor in pursuance of the advertisement dated 15-12-2023 bearing advertisement no.337/2023. The respondent no.4 has already recommended for issuance of such experience certificate by forwarding a proposal to respondent no.2 on 21-12-2023. Hence, the following order is passed:

Immediately thereafter, the mother of the applicant has filed another application before the respondents stating therein that her son

It appears that after attaining the age of 6. majority within stipulated period the applicant has filed the application seeking compassionate appointment on 22.01.2028. Thereafter he has filed reminder application on 05.02.2019 and second reminder application on 18.03.2019. Thus it cannot be said that there is total negligence on the part of the applicant. However it appears from the contents of the application and reply that there is inaction on the part of the respondents for not the aforesaid passing any order on applications/reminders. The applicant has well explained the delay. In view of same, I am inclined to condone the delay. Hence the following order:-
