4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic and the declaration of lockdown subsequent thereto and extension of it from time to time, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Suo Motu Writ Petition (C) No. 3 of 2020 has considered the said situation and directed that the period from 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022 shall stand excluded for the purpose of limitation as may be prescribed under any general or special laws in respect of all judicial or quasi-judicial proceedings. Learned counsel submits that the case of the applicant is squarely covered by the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid Suo Motu Writ Petition and as such the delay, which is not intentional or deliberate one, deserves to be condoned.

5. Learned Presenting Officer strongly resisted the application on the ground that there is an inordinate delay caused in filing the accompanying O.A., for which the applicant has not tendered satisfactory explanation and as such, the application seeking condonation of delay is liable to be rejected.

6. It appears that the civil death of father of the applicant came to be declared by the Civil Court by judgment and order dated 26.10.2018. It further appears that the respondent No. 3 by order dated 07.10.2019 turned down the request of the applicant seeking compassionate appointment on the ground that the applicant is the 3<sup>rd</sup> child of his deceased father. It is thus clear that thereafter within a period of prescribed limitation the applicant could have approached this Tribunal. Due to the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic and the declaration of lockdown subsequent thereto and extension of it from time to time, his case is squarely covered by the observations and the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Suo Motu Writ petition (C) No. 3 of 2020, wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed that certain period from 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022 shall stand excluded for the purpose of limitation as may be prescribed under any general or special laws in respect of all judicial or quasi-judicial proceedings. In view of the same, I am inclined to condone the delay caused in filing the accompanying O.A. subject to payment of certain costs by the applicant. Hence, the following order :-
