## ORAL ORDER:

- 1. Heard Shri S.D.Joshi, learned Counsel for the applicant, Shri M.P.Gude, learned Presenting Officer representing respondent nos.1 to 4 and Shri V.G.Pingle, learned Counsel for respondent no.5.
- 2. The applicant has been recently promoted from the post of Jawan to the post of ASI (State Excise). In the order of promotion dated 01-07-2022 itself it has been clarified that because of the revision in the staffing pattern of the State Excise Department, the posts of Assistant Sub Inspector (ASI) are reduced in comparison to the post of Jawan. It is further stated that as and when such district wise assignments of the posts will take place and if the posts of Assistant Sub Inspector are reduced, the candidates promoted to the post of Assistant Sub Inspector

would be liable to be reverted. The applicant has filed the present application with apprehension that on promotion, the posting which has been given to the applicant there is likelihood of the said posts getting lapsed. It is the further contention of the applicant that the applicant being senior to respondent no.5, the respondent authorities must have given posting to the applicant where the respondent no.5 has been posted. Learned Counsel for the applicant submitted that if any such occasion arises though the applicant is senior in the cadre, there is possibility of his reversion whereas the respondent no.5 is though junior to him since has been given posting on the executive post which is not going to lapse, will enjoy promotion.

3. After having gone through the documents on record, and more particularly, the order dated 01-07-2022, it appears that the apprehension in mind of the applicant is misplaced. Respondents in the said order itself have clarified that in the event of reduction of the posts of Assistant Sub Inspector, the reversion will take place in accordance with the seniority, meaning thereby that the person who is at the bottom in the seniority list will be

reverted first and in that order the reversions will take

place.

4. It is not in dispute that the applicant is senior to

respondent no.5. In the circumstances, there is no

possibility that without reverting respondent no.5, the

reversion of applicant would take place. In the

circumstances, it appears that the apprehension in the

mind of the applicant is misplaced and in fact in view of

the order dated 01-07-2022, nothing more is required to be

stated. O.A., therefore, stands disposed of with the

aforesaid observations. No order as to costs.
