- 2. Learned counsel submits that respondent Nos. 4, 5 & 6 were added as private respondents in the matter. He further submitted that insofar as respondent Nos. 4 & 5 are concerned, they have been duly served and the service affidavit in that regard has been filed in the matter. He further submitted that insofar as respondent No. 6 is concerned, the applicant could not serve the said respondent. In the circumstances, he prayed for deleting the name of the said respondent from the array of the respondents. In view of the submission made, leave granted as prayed for. The necessary amendment be carried out forthwith.
- 3. Learned Chief Presenting Officer has placed on record the documents received to him from Maharashtra Public Service Commission insofar as syllabus which

was prescribed for the concerned examination for paper No. 2 is concerned. He has also placed on record written notes of submissions along with copies of the judgments relied upon by him.
